MARRIAGE.....Troy Perry, the founder and moderator of the Universal Fellowship of Metropolitan Community Churches, married his longtime partner July 16, 2003, in Toronto. Perry and Phillip Ray De Blicke stood before Rev. Brent Hawkes the pastor of Toronto's MCC to exchange their vows. Last month the Ontario Court of Appeals struck down the federal government ban on same-sex marriage (story). Since then hundreds of Americans have traveled to Canada to marry. The longtime gay activist told a news conference following the ceremony that the more American same-sex couples who marry the greater the pressure will be on the US to revoke laws that ban gay marriage. "I don't care what the U.S. government says. My partner Phillip and I are legally married under Canadian law. We've put our nation on notice: We're coming home and we are legally married. We're now going to return to the U.S. and we're going to be missionaries for marriage equality. I am going to carry on this fight until gays and lesbians achieve equality under the marriage laws. We ask for nothing more and we'll settle for nothing less." Perry predicted that as a result of Canada legalizing same-sex marriage, gays in the United States will be able to marry within five years. from 365gay.com

In related local news—Rev. Barb Sagat (MCC-Omaha) and Rev. Sharon Stover (formerly MCC-Sioux Falls) were honored at UFMCC's General Conference in Dallas the first week of July for their actions in the Valentine's Day Marriage Action. Sagat and Stover applied at Court Houses in Nebraska and South Dakota as a part of a nation-wide campaign initiated by Perry and UFMCC to bring attention to the inequities in current marriage laws.

HOW DO YOU SHOW YOUR PRIDE?

My partner Tom and I, with a group of friends from the Men's Support Group in Omaha, took our annual Pride Trek to Minneapolis to see their Pride Festival. During the six hour drive to Minneapolis I didn't see any pride colors on any bumpers. But during our three days there of course you couldn't turn your head without seeing the pride colors flying proudly from high-rise apartments or stuck to just about every bumper or car window. We were in Pride-ville and we knew it!

However, during our drive back to Omaha – I only saw one pride sticker on the rear window of a truck – and yep, it was driven by a shorthaired blond woman. She waved and blew her horn as she drove past. It made us all feel like we had family on the same road.

The following weekend I drove to Mississippi. Through Kansas City, to St Louis, to Memphis, Tennessee, I didn't see any pride colors on any bumpers. Of course, I didn't expect to see any in Mississippi.

I have what I consider an "Oz-green" car with and "Equal Sticker" and "Rainbow Sticker" on the back bumper. In addition, I have Nebraska vanity license plates that tell those looking that I have "PRIDE".

I am not saying that every GLBT person should have Pride Colors on their car. Heck, some people are only out when their in the bars. But when they get back home – their back in the closet. For all I know you already have the colors tattooed on your rear.

My point is – I think GLBT individuals should show their PRIDE Colors. It presents a feeling that we are not alone. Sort of like a safe-zone. You remember that feeling don't you. Didn't you find yourself looking for PRIDE Colors at any time during your stages of coming out? I never want to forget the feeling of seeing those colors in the parking lots downtown at night. Those colors gave me strength. Strength that I use today to help others face the fears that I had when I came out. So, how do you show your PRIDE Colors?

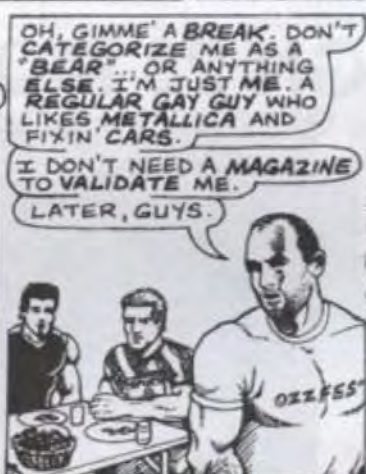

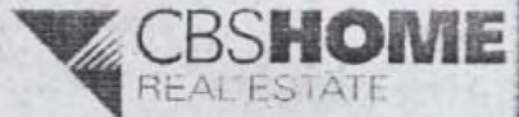
