## Christian Pastor Hopes God "Finishes The Job" And Kills Orlando Survivors

One of the many unfortunate aspects of the Pulse nightclub massacre is the number of antigay wingnuts and all-around creepos crawling out of the woodwork in order to capitalize on the attack and make a name for themselves as timely hate merchants.

A recent case in point: Pastor Donnie Romero of Stedfast Baptist Church, who Raw Story reports told his congregation he agrees "100 percent" with Roger Jimenez, the Baptist pastor



whose recent sermon suggests taking the survivors out to a firing squad to "blow their brains out."

Impossibly, Romero has added horrific new depths to this already inhuman sentiment:

"These 50 sodomites are all perverts and pedophiles, and they are the scum of the earth, and the earth is a little bit better place now," Romero said on Sunday.

"And I'll take it a step further, because I heard on the news today, that there are still several dozen of these queers in ICU and intensive care. And I will pray to God like I did this morning, I will do it tonight, I'll pray that God will finish the job that that man started, and he will end their life, and by tomorrow morning they will all be burning in hell, just like the rest of them, so that they don't get any more opportunity to go out and hurt little children."

In other key moments of Romero's sanctimonious hatemongering, he calls Sodom and Gomorrah the first ever "queer mass murder," and says he thinks other mega-churches are soft-pedaling the antigay rhetoric and should step up on the unstoppered evil.

Unsurprisingly, The Southern Poverty Law Center has categorized Romero's church as an anti-LGBT hate group.

## "Angels" Protect Orlando Funeral Attendees From Westboro Baptist Church

This Saturday, thousands of mourners congregated in Orlando, Florida to say their final goodbyes to Christopher Andrew Leinonen, one of 49 club-goers murdered by shooter Omar Mateen, the man who opened fire on the gay nightclub Pulse last weekend.



Predictably, there were also a handful of antigay activists in the crowd, including members of Westboro Baptist Church. Fortunately, their guttural gay hatred was successfully shielded by a team of intrepid counter-protesters from the city's Shakespeare Theater, who succeeded in blocking their presence with their long billowy "angel wings."

It's a strategy that's been used before, as early as 1999, when Westboro was effectively blocked from picketing the funeral of Matthew Shepard, a young man murdered in Laramie, Wyoming for being gay.

According to Jim Helsinge, artistic direction of the theater, "Angel wings are meant as a loving support to the fallen, not to create more anger or violence."

Other counter-protesters held signage that read "OrlandoStrong," held up rainbow banners, or sang "Amazing Grace."

As The Washington Post reports, the crowd cheered as the people dressed as angels made their first appearance.

"We couldn't even hear WBC," said one attendee on Facebook. "All you could hear was peace and love."

## Man Claims He Had an Intimate Relationship With Orlando Shooter

Univision interviewed a man Tuesday who claims that he had a sexual relationship with Omar Mateen for two months, and that the shooter frequented Pulse because he was attracted to Latino

"He adored Latinos, gay Latinos, with brown skin - but he felt rejected. He felt used by them - there were moments in the Pulse nightclub that made him feel really bad. Guys used him. That really affected him," said the man, identified only as "Miguel." "I believe this crazy horrible thing he did — that was revenge."

The man wore a disguise while appearing on TV. He told Univision that Mateen, who left 49 victims dead at Pulse and 53 wounded, many of whom

were Puerto Rican, held a grudge against Puerto Ricans because he felt "used" by them. Miguel claims Mateen once told him that he had sex with a man who waited until after they had intercourse to notify him that he was HIV-positive.

Mateen became paranoid that he had HIV, claimed Miguel. "I asked him, 'Did you do a test?' Yes. He went to the pharmacy and did the test ... it came out negative but it doesn't come out right away. It takes four, five months." Miguel told Univision.

"When I asked him what he was going to do now, his answer was 'I'm going to make them pay for what they did to me." said Miguel.

Miguel said he met Mateen on a gay dating site and the two quickly became "friends with benefits." Miguel described Mateen as "a very sweet guy" who "loved to be cuddled." "He was looking for love," said Miguel. The man said he was "stunned" when he heard about the shooting at Pulse because he never saw a violent side to Mateen.

Miguel claims that he met with Mateen at least 15 to 20 times but never knew his name. He only knew that Mateen was a 35year-old married man with a child. The two last met in December, and Miguel contended that Mateen's wife knew that her husband was "100 percent" gay and that their marriage was a cover for his sexuality.

The man reported that Mateen expressed resentment over his dad's views on LGBT people. He says Mateen's father believed that "gay people [are] the devil and gay people have to die."

Miguel told Univision that he's spoken with the FBI three times. Univision reported that the FBI confirmed to them that the agency had met with Miguel. But the FBI's lead investigator said Monday that "those allegations are still being vetted out as we speak and there's no determination to be made at this time." Attorney General Loretta Lynch, in a news conference today, wouldn't confirm reports that Mateen had frequented other gay bars in the area.

Mateen has been the subject of a lot of speculation over his sexual orientation. A man told MSNBC's Chris Hayes last week that he'd seen Mateen on Grindr. Another man told the Los Angeles Times a similar story and said he'd turned over his phone to the FBI. Yet another man, a former classmate, told The Palm Beach Post that Mateen had once asked him out. Three men in Fort Pierce, Fla., Mateen's hometown, told The Advocate that they'd recognized Mateen from Grindr. But in none of those cases did the men claim to have had a sexual relationship with Mateen.

Univision anchor Maria Elena Salinas asked him directly, "Why should I trust that you aren't lying to me or the FBI?"

"It's my responsibility as a citizen of the United States and a gay man," he told Salinas.

# Jim Gray Is Testing Gun Control as Way to Unseat Republicans

Kentucky's U.S. Senate race could become a powerful study in whether doing nothing to close the so-called terrorist loophole in American gun laws is actually a liability in elections.

Jim Gray, the out man running to unseat Rand Paul in the U.S. Senate, is hammering his Republican opponent for allowing "suspected terrorists to buy guns."





Gray released a new digital ad attacking Paul over his view. A voiceover asks, "When will Rand Paul vote to prevent terrorists from buying dangerous weapons?" It ends with "Rand Paul isn't just wrong, he's dangerous."

Paul is one of the many from his party who voted Monday against California Sen. Dianne Feinstein's proposal to ban anyone on the terror watchlist from being allowed to buy a gun — an idea often called "No Fly, No Buy" because people who aren't allowed to board a plane shouldn't be allowed to buy guns, advocates say.

Gray told The Advocate ahead of the vote that "it's not that complicated. If you're too dangerous to buy an airplane ticket, you're too dangerous to buy an assault weapon."

Gray also took on Paul's usual tactic of cloaking himself in the Constitution: "When we talk about the Second Amendment — I support the Second Amendment — but the Second Amendment was created and designed to prevent tyranny and not to encourage terror. We are talking about terror here; we are not talking about compromising the rights of law-abiding citizens."

For his part, Paul hasn't been talking much about gun control since the Orlando massacre when a shooter killed 49 people and wounded 53 others. He told Roll Call that he supported an alternative that nobody has actually proposed in the Senate — including him.


"I do think that there's one answer here that if we put it up, everybody could vote for it," he told Roll Call, saying advocated for the idea in his caucus. "That's the idea that if you have been investigated by the FBI, that your file remains open for five years. And that you would remain on the terror watch list."

Paul suggests that keeping a person's file open would have stopped Omar Mateen from shooting up an LGBT nightclub. Under current laws, the FBI had no warning that Mateen had purchased a semi-automatic rifle because investigators had already concluded their work. Mateen had been removed from a terror watchlist after being on it from 2013 to 2014, according to the FBI. Under those circumstances, Feinstein says her legislation would have barred Mateen from getting a gun because it included a provision that meant anyone who'd recently been on the list, even if they'd been removed, could be blocked.

Paul voted against that idea on Monday, along with 52 other senators. The only two Republicans to vote for Feinstein's proposal were Sens. Mark Kirk of Illinois and Kelly Ayotte of New Hampshire — both face reelection in close races.

Gray, the two-term mayor of Lexington, is trying to make his race closer.

"The greatest responsibility our elected officials in Washington have is to keep Americans safe," he said in a statement after Paul's vote, "Sen. Paul has repeatedly failed to meet his standard, and he did so again tonight by voting to keep open a





loophole that allows suspected terrorists to buy guns. This isn't the first time he's taken such a dangerous position but is the latest example of how out of touch Sen. Paul is with what's right for Kentucky. We need leaders who will do the right thing, not those who contribute to the dysfunction that has left Washington broken."

# 9 Truly Terrible Reactions to the Orlando Shooting

As empty as "thoughts and prayers" may be after the Orlando shooting that claimed 49 lives inside a gay nightclub, it's certainly better than the alternative. Nearly a dozen ministers, politicians, and service members have lined up to either protest support for victims, condone the massacre, and even pray for more victims — all because LGBT people were targeted. Here's what these hatemongers are saying:

#### Steven Anderson, Arizona

"The Bible says that homosexuals should be put to death in Leviticus 20:13," longtime Tempe, Ariz., hate pastor Steven Anderson said in a video, now removed by YouTube for violating rules against hate speech. "Obviously, it's not right for someone to just shoot up the place because that's not going through the proper channels. But these people all should have been killed anyway, but they should have been killed through the proper channels as in, they should have been executed by a righteous government that would have tried them, convicted them, and saw them executed. ... That's what the Bible says. Plain and simple,"

Anderson added that "the bad news" was "that a lot of the homos in the bar are still alive so they're going to continue to molest children and recruit people into their filthy homosexual lifestyle."

Anderson also said the victims were going to die of AIDS anyway and added of the 50 dead, "At least they're off the streets. I'm just trying to look at the bright side."

### Roger Jimenez, California

Recently, the congregation at the Verity Baptist Church in Sacramento was a captive audience to a venom-filled rant from their misguided leader, Pastor Roger Jimenez. He called the Orlando victims "vile, perverted predators" and added, "Are you sad that 50 pedophiles were killed today? Um, no, I think that's great! I think that helps society. I think Orlando, Fla., is a little safer tonight. ... We don't need to do anything to help. As far as I'm concerned, Orlando is just a little safer tonight."

### Donnie Romero, Texas

Jimenez has a fan in Donnie Romero, the pastor of Stedfast Baptist Church in Fort Worth. Romero told his followers he "100 percent" supports Jimenez's words and went even further:

"These 50 sodomites are all perverts and pedophiles, and they are the scum of the earth, and the earth is a little bit better place now. And I'll take it a step further, because I heard on the news today, that there are still several dozen of these queers in ICU and intensive care. And I will pray to God like I did this morn-

ing, I will do it tonight, I'll pray that God will finish the job that that man started, and he will end their life, and by tomorrow morning they will all be burning in hell, just like the rest of them, so that they don't get any more opportunity to go out and hurt little children."

### Kenneth Lewis, Florida

This assistant state attorney for Florida's Ninth Judicial Circuit didn't go after LGBT victims directly; instead he just demonized the people of color who live in downtown Orlando and frequent its businesses, like the Pulse nightchub. The proud racist posted the following on Facebook shortly after the shooting:

"Downtown Orlando has no bottom. The entire city should be leveled. It is void of a single redeeming quality. It is a melting pot of 3rd world miscreants and ghetto thugs. It is void of culture. If you live down there you do it at your own risk and at your own peril. If you go down there after dark there is seriously something wrong with you. Disney does everything in its power to shield visitors of Disney from its northern blight. That doesn't change reality. Disney may be the happiest place on Earth but Orlando is a national embarrassment. If this is an act of a domestic terrorist it is so very important that we don't publish the religion, name, or motive of the terrorist as not to offend anyone."

In a second post, Lewis wrote, "All Orlando nightclubs should be permanently closed. With our without random gunmen they are zoos, utter cesspools of debauchery."

Lewis, who previously called women "crack hoes" on Facebook, was suspended for his latest rant.

### Marines, San Diego

Marine Corps leaders are investigating an incendiary Facebook post posted by one Marine and featuring another — the image shows a service member pointing a gun at the camera and features the caption "Coming to a gay bar near you!" The man who posted the photo added, "Too soon?"

The image was shared on a closed, male-only Facebook group called CampMENdletownResale.



### San Diego Threat

Also in San Diego, though likely unrelated to the Marines, was an Orlando-related threat on Craigslist. Now removed, the post was titled "We need more Orlando's" [sic] and read, "Orlando was long overdue. Cleanse your community of the filth that gives decent gay men and women a bad name. Those people were walking diseases, bug chasers, and thank god for AIDS and 9-11 and now Orlando. San Diego you are next."

Police are investigating.

#### Westboro Baptist Church, Kansas

The infamous hate church — run by a family of Kansas kooks — went crazy on Twitter following the Orlando tragedy. They sent tweets like "God Sent the Shooter to Orlando Fag Club" and even linked to a parody song called, "Shooters Keep Comin' Around." The tune contained the following lyrics:

"I ain't gonna be an optimist / You were caught up and lost in

rage and more crisis / Marry fags as the blood flowing around you / And the shooters keep coming around in the cities that you love / Much blood flowing in the streets bringing God's wrath from above /And then he blinds your eyes..."

### Justin Rice, Brooklyn, N.Y.

Following the Orlando terror attack, this unhinged 40-year-old threatened a bouncer at Happy Fun Hideaway, a gay-friendly bar in the Bushwick neighborhood, calling him antigay slurs and saying the following: "I'm going to shoot this place up and get my 50 just like Orlando, Florida" and "I'm going to come back Orlando-style."

Rice was arrested and charged with assault, harassment, and criminal possession of a weapon.

#### Stacy White, Florida

This commissioner for Hillsborough County — which includes Tampa — is fuming after a Pride flag was raised outside county offices following the Orlando attack. White wrote a letter to human resources officials saying he received an "anonymous" call from a county worker who felt the flag created a "hostile" work environment. White insinuated the flag should be taken down until it can proved no one will be offended by its presence. County officials are looking into the anonymous complaint but have not taken down the flag.

White previously fought to keep a Confederate flag at county offices following an effort to remove it after the shooting deaths of nine African-American church attendees in South Carolina.

# 17 States Where Gay Sex Is Outlawed

There are still 17 states in the U.S. where gay sex is illegal. Incongruous as it may be in a country where same-sex marriage is legal in all 50 states, some of those states actually keep laws on the books that would criminalize relations between members of the same sex.



In 2003 the U.S. Supreme Court found sodomy laws, which criminalize certain types of sex among consenting adults, discriminatory and therefore unconstitutional in the case Lawrence v. Texas. Nevertheless, such laws persist in several Southern and Midwestern states — and, perhaps surprisingly, one Northeastern state. While it's all but impossible to convict a person for violating these archaic state laws, police officers still arrest people under the "authority" of statutes aimed at preventing "sodomy," because they either willfully ignore or are somehow unaware of the Supreme Court's decade-and-a-half-old ruling.

It's not difficult to imagine the myriad ways in which an arrestee's life might be affected when arrest records appear in

## The Cutest Thing Just Happened at the NYC Council

Children from a New York public school were honored by New York City Council members Tuesday for their fight for LGBT rights.



Fourth- and fifth-graders from the Earth School were invited to meet with council members after standing up for LGBT rights for the past year. They were assigned to do a report on LGBT rights but found that one of their favorite educational resources, BrainPOP, didn't have any information on the subject. The students and their teachers then decided to start a group and launch a campaign to get BrainPOP to include information on the subject. They made a video and formed a group called Kids 4 LGBT Rights NOW.

After the children discussed the issue with BrainPOP, officials with the educational website announced that it would include mention of LGBT issues, writing, "We acknowledged the insufficient coverage of gay rights and milestones, and shared with the school our plans for addressing the gap."

Today, during LGBT Pride Month, the students were invited to attend a New York City Council meeting and given a proclamation recognizing their work.

"All children deserve to have LGBT role models and understand what it means to be LGBT without fear of discrimination," said out City Council member Daniel Dromm during the meeting.

The students even visited the historic Stonewall Inn, often credited with launching the modern LGBT rights movement when patrons stood up to police harassment, to make their video.

# You Weren't Imagining It: More People Are Having Gay Sex

A sweeping study of sexual behavior has found men and women are either having many more sexual encounters with the same sex than before or are just more comfortable reporting the activity.

Researchers at Widener, Florida Atlantic, and San Diego State universities queried nearly 34,000 people for the study, which has been conducted annually since 1973. Participants weren't asked questions about same-sex experiences until 1989, but the percentage of people copping to queer love has doubled since then.

In 1990, only 3.6 percent of women and 4.5 percent of men said they had had at least one same-sex sexual partner; the percentage would rise to 8.7 percent and 8.2 percent, respectively, by 2014. Those numbers include both people who exclusively have same-sex relations and those who had sex with both men and women. Bisexual behavior among men and women more than doubled over the past two decades, from 3.1 percent in the early '90s to 7.7 percent two years ago. The proportion of people who had only same-sex experiences remained relatively low during the time period, with 1.7 percent of men and 0.9 percent of women describing themselves in 2014 as exclusively gay or lesbian.

The study also looked at the sexual practices among age groups. Between 2010 and 2014, only 7.5 percent of people born before World War II said they had gay sex, and the percentage was the same for millennials. More baby boomers and members of Generation X reported such encounters, 8.2 percent and 9 percent, respectively. Looking at women specifically, both millennial

and Gen X women had high percentages reporting samesex sex, with 12 percent and 11 percent, respectively.

"Lesbian sexual experience is highest when women are young, suggesting that today's 'hook-up culture' may fuel same-sex experimentation among women," re-



searcher Brooke Wells said in a statement. "Female sexual behavior is partly about performing for men, whereas male sexual behavior is often driven by their own desire. This may help explain why we don't see this same pattern for gay sexual experiences."

There was much variation among regions, with 4.5 percent of men in Eastern states reporting gay sex, 7.1 percent in the West, 9.4 percent in the South, and 10 percent in the Midwest. Among Western women, 11.3 percent noted same-sex experiences, compared to 7.4 percent in the Midwest, 7.9 percent in the East, and 8.3 percent in the South.

The study also looked at attitudes toward the morality of gay sex. While only 13 percent found gay and lesbian behavior acceptable in 1990, the number skyrocketed to 49 percent in 2014.

I've been warned not to emasculate you, to let "boys be boys," to protect your fragile ego and to not tread on your even more fragile masculinity. I've been taught to keep my emotions in check, to let you be the unit of measure for how much emotion is appropriate and to adjust my emotions accordingly. I've been taught that you're allowed to categorize women into mothers/sisters/girlfriends/wives/daughters but any woman outside of your protected categories is fair game.

So to those of you who think you're being helpful by "protecting" me and my fellow women, you're like a shark sitting in the lifeguard chair. I wasn't uncomfortable until you showed up at the pool and the only potential predator I see is you.



Your mothers, sisters, girlfriends, wives and daughters don't need you to walk them to the bathroom for safety. Your fathers, brothers, friends and sons need to walk themselves away from their own double standards. Women are sexually harassed and sexually assaulted on school campuses, on the street, at their jobs, on the Internet, in their own homes, in ANY public place. And it has been excused or ignored for so long because of what you and I are taught from the first years of our interactions with each other: You, as a male, are not accountable for your own actions. It's MY responsibility, as a female, to not "provoke" you. But then you get to knight-inshining-armor your way through life for those in your protected categories and I am expected to applaud you. Why the outrage now over bathrooms? Why aren't you outraged every single day?

If you're telling me that there are high volumes of boys and men out there, in schools or in general, who are just waiting for a "loop-hole" to sexually assault girls and women, we

have bigger problems on our hands than bathrooms. The first problem would be your apparent lack of knowledge of how often it happens OUTSIDE of bathrooms, with no "loop holes" needed. This isn't about transgender bathroom access. This is about you not trusting the boys and men in your communities and/or fearing that they're all secretly predators. Why do you have this fear? How many fathers have panicked when their daughters started dating because they "know how teenage boys can be because they used to be one"? How many times have girls been warned "boys are only after one thing"? A mother can bring her young son into the women's restroom and that's fine but a father bringing his young daughter into the men's restroom is disturbing because men are assumed to be predators and "little girls" shouldn't be exposed to that.

So instead of picking up your sword and heading to Target or the girls' locker room to defend our "rights," why don't you start somewhere that could actually make a difference? Challenge your children's schools to end sexist dress codes and dress codes that sexualize girls as young as age 5. Advocate for proper (or any) sex education classes in all public schools by a certain grade level. Focus more on teaching your sons not to rape vs teaching your daughters how to avoid being raped. Stop asking "How would you feel if that was your mother or sister?" It shouldn't take the comparison to clue you in to what's right or wrong. Question why you're more worried about your daughter being around men than your son being around women in bathrooms and dressing rooms. Stop walking by Victoria's Secret with no problem but covering your son's eves if a woman is breastfeeding in public. Stop treating your daughter's body as some fortress you're sworn to protect as if that's all she's got to offer the world.





### Beneath Anger, There is Always Sadness

In 1995, when I was a Middle School Counselor in San Francisco, I was asked to facilitate an "Anger Management Group" for the most out-of-control boys in the



One of the main things I learned from facilitating this group was that underneath anger, there is always sadness and hurt. ALWAYS. No exceptions.

When I was in middle school, in 1966, it wasn't safe to be gay in my small Ohio town. I felt so trapped and helpless there. I begged my Dad to move our family to a bigger town, where I might fit in (and I thought, desperately, that there might be more people "like me".) He refused, telling me, "You'll just have to wait 'til you go away to college."


So I was sad, hurt and, subsequently, very angry. What did I do with my anger? It wasn't safe to openly show it, so I started scratching my arms...until they bled. I wasn't exactly a "cutter", I was a "scratcher": same difference. And it did feel better: I had an external way to express my internal pain.

I also started driving very fast and recklessly. I would borrow my Mom's car and go 120 MPH on country roads. Sometimes I was going too fast to stop at stop signs.

The anger didn't stop when I got to college: I was afraid to come out there too. It was 1971 and, as an undergraduate at the University of Cincinnati, I began to sleep with other boys (clandestinely). I also bought a used Pontiac GTO (with a 396, V-8 engine) and I drove so wild and so fast that no one was willing to ride with me.

Fast-forward about 25 years.

I was facilitating the Anger Management Group for those middle school boys and they wanted to talk about cars. Sure, I said, go ahead. So they went around the circle and these tough, macho little guys talked about the cars they knew, loved and dreamed about. It was pretty typical stuff until one of the guys, the same guy who had been arrested the week before for stealing a car, said, "Yeah, I remember my uncle's Cadillac. It was pretty fine. Then one day, I saw someone shoot him dead in it."



Finally, the sadness and hurt came out. Slowly, one-by-one, all of the boys started to talk about people they knew who had been shot, killed or hurt.

A few months' later, I was driving home from the supermarket when I found myself becoming more-and-more angry at each stop sign. I started to curse other drivers, for no reason. I yelled inside my car (I'm glad the windows were up). After driving a few more blocks, I pulled the car over and looked at myself in the rear-view mirror. I asked myself, "What is going on with you?" as my therapist had encouraged me to do.

To my surprise, I began to cry. And cry. And cry. Sobbing in my car, I started to say, out loud: "I hate my job. My boyfriend doesn't really love me. I don't love him either. I don't like living in San Francisco. It's too crowded and gray here. And I feel so lonely I could die."


My sadness and hurt had finally broken through my anger. The boys had taught me well.

We can't take away other people's anger, but we sure can address our own. When you feel angry, I encourage you to dig a little deeper and find the hurt beneath it. Tend to your hurt and sadness, and I'll bet your anger and rage go away too. This is how we can take care of ourselves, and, by extension, take care of each other.

Sprinkle with remaining candy.










### Obama Proclaims LGBT Pride Month, Calls to Build on Progress President Obama

As he has in every year of his presidency, President Obama has proclaimed June as Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgender Pride Month.

The 2016 proclamation, the last for his administration, was issued today and noted the great progress made toward equal treatment of LGBT Americans — it's the first proclamation since last year's Supreme Court marriage equality ruling, which came down June 26 — but also pointed out that there is more work to be done.



"Last year's landmark Supreme Court decision guaranteeing marriage equality in all 50 States was a historic victory for LGBT Americans, ensuring dignity for same-sex couples and greater equality across State lines," the president wrote. "For every partnership that was not previously recognized under the law and for every American who was denied their basic civil rights, this monumental ruling instilled newfound hope, affirming the belief that we are all more free when we are treated as equals."

He noted his work on behalf of LGBT rights, including his 2014 executive order prohibiting companies doing business with the federal government from discriminating on the basis of sexual orientation and gender identity. He urged Congress pass legislation to this effect, "because no one should live in fear of losing their job simply because of who they are or who they love."

"LGBT individuals deserve to know their country stands beside them," Obama continued. "That is why my Administration is striving to better understand the needs of LGBT adults and to provide affordable, welcoming, and supportive housing to aging LGBT Americans. It is also why we oppose subjecting minors to the harmful practice of conversion therapy, and why we are continuing to promote equality and foster safe and supportive learning environments for all students. We remain committed to addressing health disparities in the LGBT community — gay and bisexual men and transgender women of color are at a particularly high risk for HIV, and we have worked to strengthen our National HIV/AIDS Strategy to reduce new infections, increase access to care, and improve health outcomes for people living with HIV."

The president further asserted that the need to combat discrimination "does not stop at our borders," and that "defending and promoting the human rights of LGBT individuals" is a priority in foreign policy. "In line with America's commitment to the notion that all people should be treated fairly and with respect, champions of this cause at home and abroad are upholding the simple truth that LGBT rights are human rights," he wrote.

"There remains much work to do to extend the promise of our country to every American," he went on, "but because of the acts of courage of the millions who came out and spoke out to demand justice and of those who quietly toiled and pushed for progress, our Nation has made great strides in recognizing what these brave individuals long knew to be true in their hearts — that love is love and that no person should be judged by anything but the content of their character." He closed with a call for all Americans "to eliminate prejudice everywhere it exists, and to celebrate the great diversity of the American people."

### Adult Film Actor's Dog Stabbed to Death in Park, 'Jealous' Lover Arrested



He was senselessly killed earlier today by my partner of 13 years. I will spare you the horrific details and sorry to post this post on NationalLoveYourPetDay? or anyday [sic] for that matter.
