### ST. MIKULAS DAY

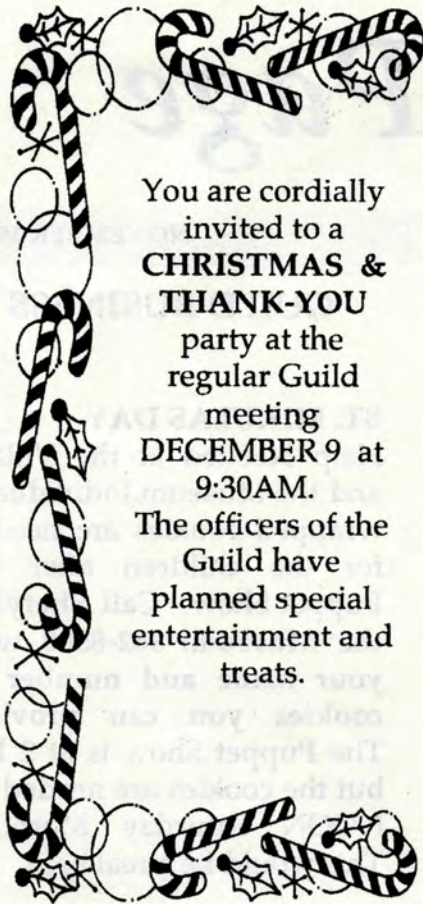
