Be it remembered, that Marie Pohorsky then residing at number 318 North 12th Street <sup>First</sup> ~~City~~ <sup>State</sup> ~~Town of~~ Cedar Rapids <sup>Territory of</sup> Iowa, who previous to her naturalization was a <sup>citizen</sup> ~~subject~~ of Czechoslovakia, having applied to be admitted a citizen of the United States of America pursuant to law, and, at a regular term of the Superior Court of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, held at Cedar Rapids, Iowa, on the 20th day of March, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-six, the court having found that the petitioner had resided continuously within the United States for at least five years and in this <sup>State</sup> ~~Territory~~ for at least one year immediately preceding the date of the filing of <sup>his</sup> ~~her~~ petition, and that said petitioner intends to reside permanently in the United States, had in all respects complied with the law in relation thereto, and that she was entitled to be so admitted, it was thereupon ordered by the said court that she be admitted as a citizen of the United States of America.

In testimony whereof the seal of said court is hereunto affixed on the 20th day of March, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-six, and of our Independence the one hundred and fiftieth.
