


The Federation of Czech Groups is the result of a concerted effort by the Czechs in Cedar Rapids area, to help their relative and friends during the Nazi expansion in 1935. In 1936 the leaders in the Fraternal and Religious organiza tions brought forth the concept of a Federation of these groups to promote the Czech Culture; Protect and Promote the Czech traditions and customs, in America. At the same time they would provide Moral and Financial support for the Czech leaders who were forced to flee their homeland.

The "Czech Radio Hour "was started in 1937.

Many thousands of dollars were raised thru

Bazaars, Dances, Plays, Letures and Concerts.

These funds were channelled thru the Czecho
Slovak National Council of America. This Council

had organized in 1918, to assist the Czech

Government in exile, and worked with Thomas G.

Masaryk, to establish the First Democracy in

Europe. We are sending our help thru that

office at this time.

During the past several years the Federation of Czech Groups has continued to promote cultural programs to perpetuate customs and heritage as; sponsoring the traditional Czech Mass, in the Historic St. Wenceslaus Church; arrange for the Memorial Day services at the Czech National cemetery; assist the Czech School; sponsor tours to Czech Plays in Chicago; support the Sokol Akademie; (slet) Houby Days; Czech Festival, and other activities of the Czech Community. 1990 brings another oppurtunity for US, to show the World that we not only give "Lip Service" to Democracy, but that we are willing to exert some

effort in providing some of the necessary
materials for the Czechoslovak people.

The Federation of Czech Groups is projecting several programs to get funds for printing equipment; medical supplies; books on
the Democratic process; and teachers for the
fldgeling nation.
