An 11,500 dollar world war service fing hones in the finorican Lofion Club Room at Wst Liberty, Iowa.

Looking at the banner you sec, a 10 by 12 soot red, whito, and bluo muslin or good quality and excolicnt sciving, with tho symbolic stars symotrically placed - nothing morc.

The only gold about it is the color or ive or the stars - two of then mountod on small rod crosses.

The flag was mado by a farm housewire who had two sons in the survice. Into the flacs ficld wont 54 blue stars, one for each Napsininoo and Goshon township onlisted youth. As onlistmonts increased Mrs. Petors added stars until tho finishod bannor had 99 additional stars alons the flag's border.

In spring of 1918 a nationwide ery for morc funds for the Red Cro s, was the inspiration for an auction sale in this small community of some 5,000 persons.
fit the conclusion of the fuction sale whore all the donated articlos wore sold, the sorvice flag was put up for sale.

James Pottor, now dead, "bid in" the banner for 850,00 and inmediately announcod ho would put the slag up for reselc.

In a chort time thero were 100 sales at 50.00 each and meny at $\$ 40.00$. Thesc wore followed by salos at 225.00 then at 15.00 and so on down to 2.50. The total amount raidod from the sale of the flac was $\$ 11,500$.

West Liberty rosidents say the sale sot a National rocord for such an event concidorating tho location and population.
