During 1967, I approved a request to establish a literary magazine at UMBC to give the opportunity for written expression that would promote cultural and academic development on campus. This approval signified administrative backing for the project, the acceptance of this magazine as a University publication and opportunity for the Student Government Association to allocate a portion of the student activities fee income to the support of the magazine, if that organization so chose.

There have been three issues of this magazine. Two appeared during the 1967-68 academic year and one last week. As is the practice in all universities, there is no prepublication censorship. The students responsible for the publication are expected to develop the publication within the laws of the state and nation and are held responsible to stand accountable thereunto.
