Resolution

This resolution, dated this 14th day of December, 1993, celebrates an agreement between The Shriver Center, newly established at the University of Maryland Baltimore County, and metropolitan Baltimore's colleges and universities,

WITNESSETH:

THAT, WHEREAS, our nation puts extraordinary and significant emphasis on voluntarism, service to our communities, and learning through work and service: and,

WHEREAS, The Shriver Center is being established to reshape and expand UMBC's existing volunteer and community service programs, and to direct more focussed attention to the problems of inner-city populations; and

WHEREAS, there resides in UMBC and its sister metropolitan colleges and universities a wealth of knowledge, skills, creativity, and optimism for the future among the faculty, students, and staffs; and

WHEREAS, Baltimore's metropolitan colleges and universities all share, and desire to benefit from, the vision and dedication of two illustrious Americans, Sargent Shriver, and Eunice Kennedy Shriver: and

WHEREAS, Baltimore's metropolitan colleges and universities, through separate agreements with The Shriver Center and UMBC, have expressed their desire to develop and support innovative programs that address the need for remedies to the problems of our central cities; and

NOW, therefore, these several parties agree that they will cooperate as partners in the activities of The Shriver Center at UMBC to ensure that significant progress is made on curing the problems of its central cities.
