as I did not know that they were here until late on Friday eve and we were on picket yesterday and came of (sic) this morning the thing that you sent are good you could not of done better I can not send the money at present to pay the express(sic) on them now but will as soon as I can draw my next pay and probaly [sic] some more with it as I have a severe headake [sic] and this is going by a friend from the 74th you will excuse this short letter and I will comply with your request of your last letter on the fore part of the week give my love to all good bye
