

Item Fourth — I hereby appoint and constitute my said wife, as my sole Executrix of this Will and Testament, and waive the giving of any Bond by her —

Item Fifth — It is my intention that my said Executrix shall hold and manage my property more in the capacity of a Trustee than an Executrix, free from the control and supervision of the Courts in any manner whatever except so far as may be necessary for the mere probating of this will —
