

Strategic Plan List - February, 2009

- A. Finish the ongoing restoration and replication of 6 period, 1850s Rococo window cornices for the double parlor (ACHF and House Committee donation to the project is \$13,500).
- B. Finish a quality audio tour recording and purchase CD players to assist with interpretation of the house.
- C. Provide docents for interpretation of the house upon request.
- D. **Complete an appropriate period landscape master plan.**
- E. Install an appropriate period formal Boxwood garden on the front lawn of the house.
- F. Install period tie-back drapery hardware in all period rooms.
- G. Fix water problem and repair damage in back double parlor.
- H. **Complete faux graining for upstairs hall doors** and possible faux marbling for down and upstairs baseboards.
- I. Use of period wallpaper in appropriate locations.
- J. Furnish and interpret upstairs bedroom.
- K. New acquisitions of important family items or Athens-specific decorative arts or furniture which would improve the collection for historic interpretation.
- L. Lessen the impact of modern mechanical devices in the dining room ceiling. Decorate ceiling with historically accurate design compatible with the period of the wall decorations.
- M. Acquire and improve display items in the Athens Historic Display Room when possible.
- N. Continually update Patrons Book (complete memorial page for Ms. Patsy).
- O. Continue decorative arts education class using the Lyndon House as the laboratory.
- P. Continue fund raising effort to assist in completing the above list (install donation box for tour donations).
