AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DEMONSTRATIONS BY MEMBERS OF THIS ORDINANCE AS BE CITED AS 8.0. \$71-5-N-996 WHEREAS, public demonstration by members of political parties wearing military-style uniforms is repugnant to the tradition of civilian control of government and is repugnant to the standards of morality and decency of the people of the Village of Skokie: NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that Chapter 28 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Skokie be amended by the addition thereto of Section 28-42, as follows: 10 11 Sec. 28-42 Prohibition of demonstrations by members 12 of political parties wearing militarystyle uniforms. 13 No person shall engage in any march, walk 14 Sec. 28-42.1 or public demonstration as a member or on behalf of any political party while 15 16 17 wearing a military-style uniform. Sec. 28-42.2 "Political party" is hereby defined as an 18 organization existing primarily to influence 19 and deal with the structure or affairs of 20 21 government, politics or the state. Sec. 28-42.3 22 The Corporation Counsel of Skokie is 23 hereby empowered to seek an injunction in the Circuit Court of Cook County to re-24 strain any person, group or organization from violating this ordinance. 25 26 Sec. 28-42.4 Any violation of this ordinance shall be 27 deemed to be a misdemeanor and upon con-28 29 viction thereof, any person found guilty 30 shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00, or by imprisonment in the 31 County Jail for not more than six (6) months, or by any combination of the foregoing 32 33 for each offense. 34 Sec. 28-42.5 The invalidity of any section or part of 35 this ordinance shall not affect the 36
