

1 AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DEMONSTRATIONS BY MEMBERS OF  
2 POLITICAL PARTIES WEARING MILITARY-STYLE UNIFORMS

THIS ORDINANCE MAY  
BE CITED AS

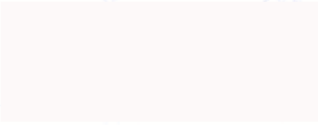
3 WHEREAS, public demonstration by members of political  
4 parties wearing military-style uniforms is repugnant to the  
5 tradition of civilian control of government and  
6 is repugnant to the standards of morality and decency of the  
7 people of the Village of Skokie;

8 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that Chapter 28  
9 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Skokie be amended  
10 by the addition thereto of Section 28-42 , as follows:

- 11 Sec. 28-42 Prohibition of demonstrations by members  
12 of political parties wearing military-  
13 style uniforms.
- 14 Sec. 28-42.1 No person shall engage in any march, walk  
15 or public demonstration as a member or  
16 on behalf of any political party while  
17 wearing a military-style uniform.
- 18 Sec. 28-42.2 "Political party" is hereby defined as an  
19 organization existing primarily to influence  
20 and deal with the structure or affairs of  
21 government, politics or the state.
- 22 Sec. 28-42.3 The Corporation Counsel of Skokie is  
23 hereby empowered to seek an injunction in  
24 the Circuit Court of Cook County to re-  
25 strain any person, group or organization  
26 from violating this ordinance.
- 27 Sec. 28-42.4 Any violation of this ordinance shall be  
28 deemed to be a misdemeanor and upon con-  
29 viction thereof, any person found guilty  
30 shall be punished by a fine of not more  
31 than \$500.00, or by imprisonment in the  
32 County Jail for not more than six (6) months,  
33 or by any combination of the foregoing  
34 for each offense.
- 35 Sec. 28-42.5 The invalidity of any section or part of  
36 this ordinance shall not affect the  
37 validity of the remaining sections or  
38 parts.

1 This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect  
2 from and after its passage, approval and publication, as  
3 required by law.
