IF YOU WISH TO SPEAK DURING THE MEETING

. . . there are a few simple rules governing your participation. These rules were adopted by the Board of Trustees in 1960.

- The President of the Village is the presiding officer. He decides on all questions of order.
- Any person or delegation may be recognized by the President to speak on any matter under discussion. Each speaker should identify himself and state his address.
- Unless otherwise specified by the Board, a delegation's presentation should be limited to five minutes.
- To insure a dignified debate and a fair presentation of all sides of a given question, in all cases, strict observance of parliamentary rules shall prevail.

ZONING CLASSIFICATIONS

R-1 Single Family Dwelling — minimum frontage of 55 feet with an area of at least 6,600 square feet of lot area of which not more than 35 percent is occupied by house.

R-2 Same as R-1 except minimum frontage is 40 feet, minimum lot area is 4,800 square feet.

R-3 Two family residence (two-flat or duplex) land requirements R-2.

R-4 Multiple Dwellings — permits apartments or townhouses.

B-1 Neighborhood Shopping — retail permitted. Dwellings permitted under requirements similar to R-2.

B-2 Permits Commercial mixed retail and service plus indoor amusements. Dwellings permitted similar to requirements of R-4.

B-3 Heavy Service Business and Filling Stations. Dwellings permitted similar to requirements of R-4.

B-4 Regional Shopping.

M-1 Office and Assembly Industry.

M-2 Light Industry.

M-3 Heavy Industry.

Check zoning ordinance for specific requirements. All Skokie Zoning classifications require off street parking. Consult code for off-street parking requirements in each zone.
