To that end we shall favorably consider providing whatever hospitality and generosity of spirit necessary to receive, embrace and be reached for in gratitude for blessings uniting the Jewish people as one in its common concerns.

Furthermore be it hoped for that such visits not only be in response to but in awareness of that which motivates a sense of Jewish People, one and indivisible, now and at all times.
