LIVE WHERE YOU WANT TO LIVE:

Skokie has Fair Housing Ordinances which guarantee to all persons an equal opportunity to purchase, lease, rent or occupy housing and other real estate without discrimination based on race, religion, color, national origin or ancestry. These ordinances apply to real estate brokers as well as individual owners and other persons. Prior to seeking an accommodation you may wish to contact the Skokie Human Relations Commission for information or assistance.

IF YOU FEEL

- YOU were denied the opportunity to buy or rent a house, apartment or business accommodation...
- YOU were told a house, apartment or business accommodation wasn't available when it really was...
- YOU were offered different terms or conditions of sale or rental than someone else...

YOU SHOULD

- Be sure to get the name and address of the renter, seller, or agent with whom you speak - both by phone or in person.
- Note the date and time whenever you speak or meet with the renter, seller, or agent.
- Offer to leave a deposit if you would like to buy or rent the accommodation.

YOU CAN

THE SKOKIE HUMAN RELATIONS COMMISSION COULD
