Dear Rabbi Brief:

There will be a meeting to discuss the general reactions and responses of the community of Skokie in the event that all legal remedies are exhausted and the American Socialist Party (Nazis) is able to march. A number of interested citizens have indicated that there is a need for some type of contingency planning.

It has further been suggested that the Industrial Areas Foundation be used to assist the community in these planning efforts. The Industrial Areas Foundation is an organization founded by Saul Alinsky which provides training and assistance in grass roots organizing efforts.

In general, the meeting will be an open discussion of the "Nazi" situation but will focus on the question of using the Industrial Areas Foundation in Skokie.
