

MAYOR' S REPORT REGARDING THE PROPOSED NAZI MARCH

AS A RESULT OF THE DECISION WHICH CAME FROM JUDGE DECKER'S COURT, WE HAVE HAD A CONSIDERABLE INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF LETTERS AND PHONE CALLS. TODAY ALONE, WE WERE IN RECEIPT OF 67 PIECES OF MAIL AND WITH THE EXCEPTION OF TWO, ALL WERE SUPPORTIVE IN THEIR CONTENT.

THESE LETTERS CAME FROM A TOTAL OF ONE FOREIGN COUNTRY, NAMELY CANADA, AND 23 STATES: ARIZONA, CALIFORNIA (9) CONNECTICUT, FLORIDA (5) HAWAII, ~~ILLINOIS~~, INDIANA, IOWA, KANSAS, MARYLAND, MISSOURI, NEW JERSEY (3) NEW MEXICO, NEW YORK (5) NORTH CAROLINA, OHIO (3) PENNSYLVANIA, SOUTH DAKOTA, TEXAS, VIRGINIA, WASHINGTON, WEST VIRGINIA AND WISCONSIN. THE BALANCE FROM VARIOUS COMMUNITIES IN THE STATE OF ILLINOIS.
