JM:re Encl: AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DEMONSTRATIONS BY MEMBERS OF THIS ORDINANCE NACLIFICAL PARTIES WEARING MILITARY-STYLE UNIFORMS

THIS ORDINANCE AS

EX CITED AS BE CITED AS VC 11-5-N-996 WHEREAS, public demonstration by members of political parties wearing military-style uniforms is repugnant to the 4 tradition of civilian control of government and 5 is repugnant to the standards of morality and decency of the people of the Village of Skokie; 7 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that Chapter 28 8 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Skokie be amended 9 by the addition thereto of Section 28-42, as follows: 10 Prohibition of demonstrations by members וו Sec. 28-42 of political parties wearing military-12 13 style uniforms. 14 Sec. 28-42.1 No person shall engage in any march, walk or public demonstration as a member or on behalf of any political party while 15 16 wearing a military-style uniform. 17 18 Sec. 28-42.2 "Political party" is hereby defined as an 19 organization existing primarily to influence and deal with the structure or affairs of 20 government, politics or the state. 21 Sec. 28-42.3 The Corporation Counse) of Skokie is 22 23 hereby empowered to seek an injunction in the Circuit Court of Cook County to re-24 strain any person, group or organization 25 from violating this ordinance, 26 Sec. 28-42.4 27 Any violation of this ordinance shall be deemed to be a misdemeanor and upon con-28 viction thereof, any person found guilty shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00, or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than six (6) months, 29 30 31 32 or by any combination of the foregoing 33 for each offense. 34 Sec. 28-42.5 The invalidity of any section or part of this ordinance shall not affect the 35

validity of the remaining sections or

parts.
