Joint Committee Meeting of Skokie Public Library Board and School Board of Skokie District 68.

The joint Library Board - School Board committees met for the purpose of discussing and reviewing joint plans for library and educational improvement to the community. As previously announced, District 68 is planning to present a referendum to purchase property adjacent to the north of Old Orchard Junior High and Sharp Corner School (approximately two acres) for the purpose of adding to the Old Orchard Junior High School building.

The Skokie Public Library Board plans to propose a referendum to acquire the balance of the triangle extending to Gross Point Road and Niles Center Road for the purpose of erecting a branch library.

The joint committees arrived at consensus in their plans, the details of which will be revealed by the Library Board to the Village Board. Committee members noted that since neither board was in formal session all agreements were subject to the ratification of the full boards.
