The early records are more or less incomplete. Also at the time of the Revolution Hanson was known as the West Parish of Pembroke. There were approximately one hundred and fifty men whose enlistments were credited to the West Parish. We have found fifty one graves.

While there may be some question as to whether or not a veteran has been buried in those graves which we have assigned even though no stone was found, we feel justified in assuming that he is buried there when other members of his family are buried close by and when his grave has not been found elsewhere.

In regard to the plainly marked graves we feel that there can be

little doubt but what veterans are buried there.

Veterans Graves in Hanson - All Wars

Records compiled under 3PA project #21393

The purpose of this project was to establish a permonent record of the graves of veterans of all wars beginning with the Revolution. This record includes (1) Place of burial and location in cemetery (2) Date of birth and death (3) War record (4) Type of stone mark-

ing grave.

In order to decide whether or not the deceased was a veteran it was necessary to check every stone in each cemetery. If it were possible for the deceased to have been a veteran of any war we checked with the war records of the Adjutant General and if we found an enlistment credited to Hanson or a nearby town, which checked with with the information found on the stone we assumed that we had located the grave of a veteran. In cases where the persons were born in other towns or cities we assumed that those persons were veterans provided that we could find enlistments credited to those towns or cities where the persons were born. In a few cases (all Revolutionary) we found graves marked as being the wife of the veteran. If we found an unmarked grave beside it we allotted the unnarked grave to the veteran even though we had no definite proof that he was buried there. In the case of the Winter Street Tomb we accepted information received from Mr. Lucius Arnold, an old inhabitant of this town that Thomas Pratt a Revolutionary war veteran was buried there.

In so far as possible we checked the birth and death records with

town clerk's records.

We have also compiled a record of all veterans credited to Hanson

who died in the service even though they were not buried here.
Anyone wishing to locate the graves of any of these veterans may do so by consulting the maps which we have prepared now on file with the Selectmen.

Following is a record of each veteran listed by wars.

There were seven men from Hanson whose enlistments were credited to the West Parish of Pembroke for the War of 1812. We have found three of their graves.
One of these seven men, John Cook, died at the Infirmary and was buried in Fern Hill but we could not locate his grave.

CIVIL WAR

We have located the graves of ninety Civil War veterans. They are all in Fern Hill Cemetery. There are a good many Hanson men buried in surrounding towns and likewise some of those buried here enlisted from other towns.

We found records of nineteen men credited to Hanson who died

in the service during this war, not buried here.
The Civil War records ocmpiled by Mr. Dana Pratt were of much assistance to us in preparing our own records.
