## INTRODUCTION.

---

THE Committee have to thank those members of the Sunday School Association, and other friends, who were so kind as to look over the proof sheets of this Catalogue, and to return them with friendly approbation of the undertaking, thoughtful criticism, and valuable suggestions. Of these last, many have thankfully been accepted, and others, which must be postponed owing to pressure of time and want of room in the Catalogue, will appear in a Second Edition, which it is the present intention of the Committee to bring out at no distant period. In the present Edition, great pains have been taken to ensure correctness in the information given in the various columns; and, although the Editors cannot hope to have kept their work quite free from mistakes, they believe these will be found to be very few.

The Classification will indicate in a general way the use to which each work is adapted. In Part I. books have been selected with a view to the very varied qualifications of the teachers in our Sunday Schools—those which will be found most useful to the large class of teachers who have not much time for preparation being marked by an asterisk. As, moreover, many of the books placed in the Young People's List might with advantage be read to the scholars, the Catalogue, it is hoped, will afford no inconsiderable help to that class of teachers which most needs help. Doubtless further research, especially in the field of American Sunday School literature, will enable future editors to add most usefully to this portion of the Catalogue. In Part I. a few valuable books have been retained, which, although they are known to be now out of print, may still be found in libraries, and occasionally purchased at second-hand.

No apology is needed for the introduction into the Teachers' List of works by those well-known orthodox writers, whose learning, eloquence, and earnest religious feeling, every cultivated mind will be glad occasionally to be in company with. In connection with the Young People's Historical Fiction, however, it ought to be pointed out that the novels of Mrs. Charles must be taken with reservation. The theology is decidedly objectionable; and the books should, therefore, be read by those who are of an age to have been taught other religious views, but who, at the same time, are able to take delight

in the living impression conveyed by the author of the spirit of the times in which the scenes are laid. These books are placed in the Catalogue for the sake of their *historical*, not their *theological* truth. In the Children's Fiction, the "Leilas," and the stories by the author of "Jessica's First Prayer," though orthodox, have been accepted for the sake of their singular beauty, which, it is thought, outweighs the objectionable dogma.

Sections II., III., IV., and V. of Part II. will, it is hoped, prove useful in the formation of School Libraries.

A feeling is growing very rapidly in the educational world that it is of the utmost importance to cultivate the observing powers of children, and as this is to be done only by bringing them in contact with *things*, it has been judged not out of place to introduce into the Catalogue the mention of the Kindergarten and of the Scientific Apparatus and Collections, Models, &c., &c., sold by Myers & Co.\* These will be found useful at Week-day Evening Classes, Lectures, &c.
