significant architectural detail: The house is built without nails. It is all frame with wood pegs and tongue-in-groove joints. The porch is a type not often found.

relationship to surroundings: Adjacent to newer residential structure in rural area.

description: One story frame structure with small 6/6 windows. There is a chimney on the northwest side of the house. The gabled roof extends to form an unusual porch on the south end of the structure. There are four doors across the front (south side) of the house, a single door on either side and a double set in the middle.

historic information: The house has always been in Mrs. Fritz's family, having been built in about 1849 by Schreiner Pfeil. Schreiner is the German word for carpenter, Pfeil's occupation.
