

Phillip Ruempel (1837-1909), a mason and farmer, was born in Offenbeck, Germany, the son of Johannes Ruempel (born 1801) and Christina Sinnborn Lex (born 1802). Phillip Ruempel immigrated to Texas, landing in Galveston in 1855, with other families from Offenberg and Bicken, Germany. Phillip was married to Carolina Braun (1849-1935) and their farm was located just east of Zion Lutheran Church at the corner of Braun Road and Loop 1604. The They had 11 children. Their son Willie died home still stands. of a snake bite at the age of 10. Their son Christian died at the age of 23 of pneumonia during an influenza epidemic. Their son, Karl Joseph (Charles) Ruempel (1870-1955) married Helen Zellenwits (1875-1963). Their farm was located on Hwy 1560 south of Braun Road. Both Phillip Ruempel and his son, Karl Joseph (Charles) Reumpel, were charter members of Zion Lutheran Church of Helotes, and are buried in Zion Lutheran Cemetery.












