PROPOSED RESOLUTIONS TO BE DISCUSSED AT THE SCRIPPS COLLEGE COMMUNITY MEETING OF STUDENTS, FACULTY, AND ADMINISTRATION (INCLUDING ALL STAFF) TO BE HELD AT 10:30 a.m. in the HUMANITIES BUILDING COURTYARD

1. We of this Scripps College Community Meeting deplore Nixon's escalation of the undeclared war in Southeast Asia, and particularly the U.S. invasion of Cambodia. We are outraged that the President, acting on the advice of the military, and contrary to the advice of his Secretary of State and Secretary of Defense, would use his executive authority without consulting the Congress. We believe that the war in Vietnam and its recent extension by the President into Cambodia violates the spirit of the United States Constitution and divides the country more deeply than before.
2. We condemn the actions of the Ohio State National Guard on May 4, 1970, resulting in the death of students, and demand that those responsible be brought to trial.
3. We disapprove of the interim power of summary suspension held by the presidents of the Claremont Colleges, and hereby urge the President of Scripps to use his influence in such a way as to prevent summary suspension of students from any of the Claremont Colleges.
4. We recommend to the Scripps faculty that all students summarily suspended from any of the Claremont Colleges as a result of the current protests against ROTC be permitted to remain in Scripps classes. In the event that any women students from the Claremont Colleges other than Scripps are suspended, as a result of current protests against ROTC, let it be known that Scripps welcomes their applications for admission.
5. We call on the trustees of Scripps College to divest the college of stocks in any war-related industry and to reinvest that capital in a manner conducive to peace, including reallocation of financial transactions in a bank other than the Bank of America. *Lyttor Inc, & Boes-Allen & Hamilton*
6. We urge any college and especially CMC to discontinue policies of reporting to respective draft boards the names of all students leaving the college without the consent of the student.
7. We demand the immediate removal of the Scripps College emblem from all ROTC stationery.
8. We urge Pomona and CMC to discontinue all ROTC operations. We urge that none of the Claremont Colleges ever again establish ROTC operations on campus.
9. We urge that under no circumstance should the President of Scripps College call to the campus civil authorities.
