## OPS-504 SPECIAL EVENTS

### 1. INTRODUCTION

#### Objective

1.1 The objective of this policy is to ensure that the Service meets its mandated responsibility as it relates to special events and that the role and responsibilities of Service participants in this regard are clear and defined.

#### Definition

1.2 **Special Event:** Any event, in Canada or abroad, which provides a heightened opportunity for carrying out activities which may constitute a threat to the security of Canada, as defined in Section 2 of the CSIS Act.
