REGARDING THREAT REDUCTION ACTIVITIES PURSUANT TO S.12.1 OF THE CSIS ACT

1. REFERENCES

CSIS and GAC have developed an enhanced consultation mechanism (ECM) regarding consultation related to threat reduction activities (TRA) pursuant to s.12.1 of the CSIS Act.

2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this ECM is to:

- Identify the reporting requirements for executed s.12.1 measures.

3. DEFINITIONS

Threat Reduction Activity (TRA), also referred to as s.12.1 threat reduction measures, refers to operational measures undertaken by CSIS further to s.12.1 of the CSIS Act, where the principal purpose is to reduce a threat to the security of Canada, as defined in s.2 of the CSIS Act. The measures may be taken within or outside of Canada.

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
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Warrant Review Committee (WRC) is a committee struck to review all CSIS warrant applications. WRC is composed of ADM level representatives within CSIS and outside of CSIS as appropriate given the subject matter of the warrant application.

5. CONSULTATION WITH GAC

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Reporting requirements - Intermediate and strategic outcomes:

- 9. The Service will provide intelligence assessments to GAC of the intermediate and strategic outcomes (i.e., the medium and long term impact) of TRA measures which have a foreign policy component. GAC recognizes that the timeframe required for achieving the intermediate and strategic outcomes varies from measure to measure.
- 10. GAC can request information from CSIS on the status of an ongoing TRA measure or on the intermediate and strategic outcomes of TRAs as appropriate.
