

Samuel D. Tilton sold a portion of his land to James F. and Myra Greenleaf:




James F. Greenleaf was awarded a permit to build a two story, wooden dwelling house 33 X 18 with a pitch roof. The location was listed as 63 Webb St. which has since been renumbered to 89 Webb St. (Salem Building Permits stored at the Essex Institute)
