The land purchase in 1879 plus the building permit marked as completed in 1879 make the date of this dignified handsome Victorian style mansion unmistakeable. A large carriage house was moved onto the rear of the lot a few years later, and this building exhibits evidence of being perhaps 20 years older, but the exact date is impossible to determine.
