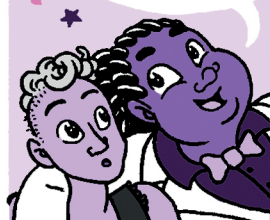


Yeah okay, but what do you mean by

That's an excellent question!



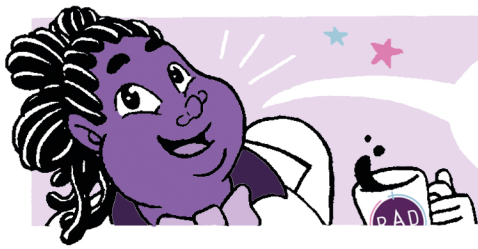

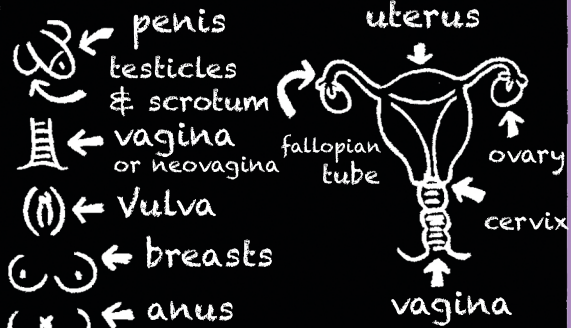
