The mood of the young can be seen clearly as despair. The sense found among people is that the future offers little considering the prophecies of environmental doom and a State of the Union in which the individual is completely controlled by the state, with the state programming his thoughts.

This Spring will be of interest. It will begin the decade in which the world has been told that it must conform to nature and its delicate forms or die. It will follow a harsh Winter where the Administration had its way and made many uneasy about the future. The Administration also made many uneasy by its fiscal policies which are viewed in some economic circles as barbaric, sacrificing people for the sake of business.
