

A PUBLIC APPEAL FROM L.S.E. STUDENTS

On Friday January 24th, the students of the London School of Economics tore down steel grill-gates erected against them. Today we make this general appeal.

The Press Barons try to set workers against students by saying that students are misusing your taxes. **Yet it is they who misuse your taxes and your lives!** The bosses and the Government want universities to produce future rulers and managers. We say **NO!** The 'quiet, respectable' student accepts his role as a future exploiter. **We are against exploitation itself.**

We are fighting against the Big Business bosses who run our university, and we are fighting because we are socialists. We appeal not to the governors, the bosses and the Government who rule **us and you.** It is to the vast majority we appeal, those who are ruled like us. We want a society which is controlled directly by the organised working class, not by Big Business. We believe that if the building workers controlled the building resources they would build houses for the homeless, not luxury offices for the bosses. We believe that if printworkers controlled their newspapers they would argue against the capitalist system of inequality, exploitation and privilege.

Today, we students of the London School of Economics appeal to all, especially those active in the workers' organisations, to take all possible actions to register support for us, verbal and physical.

Our interests are identical with those of the vast majority. Our school is locked and guarded against us as this leaflet is printed, our comrades have been arrested and face serious charges.

Why? Because we are fighting capitalism.
