

## **Anarchist Sentenced In English Bombings**

LONDON, Dec. 1 (AP).—Jack Prescott, 26, an admitted revolutionary, was jailed for 15 years at the Old Bailey Court today for conspiring to cause explosions in London and other English cities.

Prescott, an anarchist who was cleared yesterday of bombing the home of Employment Minister Robert Carr earlier this year, also received a five-year prison term on eight fraud counts.

He was sentenced at the end of a two-week trial resulting from a wave of explosions at the homes of prominent persons. The Angry Brigade, an underground anarchist group, has claimed responsibility for the blasts.
