Even as borrowed illusions the concepts of class-struggle and capitalism were meaningless. These categories have long since dissapeared with all the landmarks of reality, into a vortex of technological change and with them the political significance of marxism. As religious experience, the community versus the state, there is a vision leading from Marx to the limits of the I9th century, but nothing intact crosses the dimension gap which seperates the 19th from the 20th. The state itself is hallucination, the after-image of an obsolete authority (History) that persists all the more sharply and painfully on the retinue because no alternative that is not also an authority can be envisaged to take its place....

People everywhere confront abstractions and hallucination And are themselves the alternative to both.

Surely enough, the most vehement opponents of student revolt were the ones saw the situation most clearly. The issue was anarchic. The message was explosive. Only the rationalizations coming later in the staged debates gave any impression that the issues were, or could have been, linear and structural.

The VOICE was humane poetic and religious. The goal was nothing less

than Creation Inevitably many of the students reassessed and withdrew to speak with the voice of their opponents in striving to re-phrase the Inevitable Revolution into the static propositions and cat -egories of the

AFTER MAY, society could not be rebuilt & There is a hole in the world rationality has no power -an uneasy silence in to make that possible but the Laboratory offers irresistable attractions to experiment -while the mind again becomes subtly unfree

It is the dilemma of all revolt without dissociation But how should the students know this? Universities cannot teach the nature of knowledge or the penetration -fuckingof fact by imagination or the destruct to ion of reality by simoultaneous perceltion. Rationality is a violent technique -violent to the whole-mind of intelligence- and rationality is the language of the Universities ...

In ZEN, at the moment of Satori, the inadequacy of reason to grasp and resolve is finaly exposed as the key illusion to the entire cycle. And correctly discriminated, revolution is a Satori to the whole of a society. the point at which certain transformations have become actual and may be realised and freely entered into. The retreat of many of the students from their initial flash of Satori was partly reflex and partly the concealed feedback from their predominantly rational techniques ... a coverage of vision that again projects phenomena of a fragmented problem-ridden society appealing through the logic (music) of its own illusion to the same fragmented solutions.

There have been few revolutions that have escaped this music and the structured, politicized version of the May revolt would have been no exception but for one fact which by itself cancels regression and removes the solid earth, society is no longer a machine but an

extension

of the human nervous system open to the constant flow of all impulses and to the pulse-motion of the whole universe. The technique & language of revolution/satori -of electronics, the 20th century itself- is poetry, which can feed the hungry, expend violence, build cities and order the ecology & resources of the planet yet which does not create systems. But this is not at first an obvious truth.

Society as Holy Madness, as dance, polarizes the rational mind which cannot experience the connection between the illusory opposites, between frenzy and compassion, between Dionysus and Buddha, the saving translations.

The compromises which a percentage of the students may find themselves accepting cannot be satisfactory for long, and even if it could the modifications and new social groupings would again be nullified by fresh surges of revolutionary action following inevitably from the the first.

Predictable is that the second flash-point will come with the revolt of imagination against the re-instatement of rationality, the emergence of imagination from 'underground' & this could lead to a mass abandonment of the universities and a wide, intensified period of inquiry and activity that we should now be prepared to meet.

The electric transformations of man disintegrate the barrier between man and society and initiate a total situation where it is no longer enough to create only a superficial fusion of imagination and environment, Insight must enter into the forms and transpose them. If this is not done the hallucinations of the rational solution will revive, & with it violence and loss of the actual victory which the May revolution achieved.

This country is better suited than either America or Europe to create the transpositions. We inherit a cool with the landscape, a genius for practical life and for poetry and institutions that are not so much repressive as semile, and powerless against the right choice of tecnique. Imported revolution is worse than useless to us. The revolution we are poised to make can expand far more effectively through planned freeing of living materials, food, housing, communications ...which becomes possible by simoultaneously liberating the mind from the false survival value that attach it to these things.

As far as the 'true' underground is concerned Holy Madness turned a lot of people on as a new kind of groovy condition to be in -but most of the abstractions are still there. Most of the things that were on sale before are still on sale. It was a beautiful theme, from spring forward, but from May onwards it becomes crucial to go deep into the arena and consistently fuck everything, everywhere, until there really is no difference between theory and realisation.

Since May there is a hole in the world -the dimension gap finaly made actual -In the silence it is not bourgeois culture cracking, or the overtones of new violence, what you hear is the approaching music of a compassionate bacchanal ... The season of Holy Madness is hardly yet begun!

But better news is coming from Utrecht; since a few months there has been a DIGGERSHOP at the Kargadoor, Marnix laan 322. These people dont want to sell anything, so the shop should be clean. Kargadoor is the Utrecht underground centre which started the diggershop SELF, so they had only to make a place for it in their own building. There is a room on the street-side where all people can come and bring things and take things, listen to music, read magazines etc, a nice relaxing place ... They are now working for a Release centre: they are trying to help pot smokers with free legal assistance and by distributing information sheets about what to do if arrested, they are also working for a documentation centre and for psychiatric help (u.o.)by phone) They are starting a course on consciousness expansion. Other people from Kargadoor are starting a scheme for crash-pads. In September they will have a weekend for all kinds of underground people, to communicate horizontaly -an insight into the whole underground; music, arts, lightshows politics, etc.

So you will only find Digger activities now in Utrecht... 40 km from Amsterdam

EITHER HOLLAND'S CONSUMER-ORIENTED SOCIETY IS TOO CLAUSTROPHOBIC FOR ANYTHING TO SURVIVE IN -OR OUTSIDE IT-FOR LONG, OR THE DUTCH PROVO/UNDER-GROUND IS RE-CASTING ITS APPROACH & ITS STRATEGIES AND PASS-ING THROUGH A PHASE SIMILIAR TO THE ONE WE HAD HERE AT THE BEGINNING OF THE YEAR.. COMPLICATED MAYBE BY THE STRONG POLITICAL BIAS OF THE ORIGINAL PROVO MOVEMENT. THE BIAS REMAINS BUT POLITICS ARE BEGINNING TO SHOW UP AS ANOTHER KIND OF CONSUMER GOODS. WHEN A SAME KIND OF DISILLUSION-MENT HIT THE WEST COAST, AND LATER HERE IN ENGLAND, THE DIGGERS APPEARED WITH FRESH ANSWERS TO THE WHOLE QUEST-ION OF FREE COMMIT-MENT IN OVER-WIEGHT-ED CONSUMER SOCIETIES

TO FIND OUT HOW THE SCENE FEELS IN AMST-ERDAM WE ASKED OUR FRIEND JAN SWAGERMAN, WHO FIRST INTRODUCED THE DIGGER MOVEMENT IN HOLLAND, IN WITTE KRANT, TO COMMENT ON THE SITUATION. HE SENT THIS ACCOUNT OF THE DIGGERSHOP IN AMSTERDAM AND A TRAN-SLATION OF A LEAFLET DISTRIBUTED BY THE DUGGER RADICALS IN THE CITY

MASTERDAN

HOLLAND had the first DIGGERSHOP in Europe -but that doesn't mean that there is still a Digger scene now.

Last year we -some people who met at love-ins- started the idea of opening a diggershop. We went to the Anker club foun-ation which gave us a very nice place where later the whole underground should come. Every friday there (in FANTASIO) is 'Provadya', a kind of Middle Earth, but nicer because there is also a teahouse and a restaurant in it. So we had the first diggershop on the scene, in Prins Hendrikkade, which is just outside the city.

There is music on friday nights, as part of the 'Provadya' program. The shop looks nice, like a good boutique, all walls are black decorated with colored flower-like designs. Later a balcony also was added -- but gradualy it has nothing to do with a diggershop...it became the first PSYCHEDELIC shop in the city.

We had to begin with selling things to pay for expenses but because Fantasio became an underground centre the money we paid to Fantasio was money for the underground. But at last you could only BUY there. One part of the shop was for selling and one part for free exchange, but always there was more to sell than to exchange. During the first month fjanuary this year) people came with nice things -and also with some junk- A real diggershop was possible!! You should not forget that the digger idea is new for this materialistic country. So are the hippies. During this time for several months there were hippies, all weekend hippies, people who came to the love-ins because they had nothing else to do, but in this short time the hippie idea became known by the big publicity. So I thought that if the name DIGGERS should also be known through the press it could make the diggers -attract other people who agreed with the diggers and wanted to help further

...because the diggershop was becoming a shop without diggers!

Just the people who started the shop, school-boys and people
from the love-ins who had niether the time nor knowledge of
keeping a shop... You have to understand that there is no
community life here, only some friends who are working in the
same way...

So we looked out for some people who could help, for people who could be every day at the shop, people for the administration etc, so there came other outsiders: artists who painted the shop, who worked long days while the others were at school. But these people were not diggers at all, so slowly it became a place where you could PLAY shopkeeping, selling posters, clothes, records, books, rings, tosti's, jasmine tea, etc.

I was there several months with an exchange corner, but it was diffucult to do digger things in a place where nobody any longer believed in the digger's idea, and where people did'nt come to exchange because the shop had got the image of a cheap (?) boutique and now nobody knows what diggers other will be than cheap (?) shopkeepers. The diggers have a false

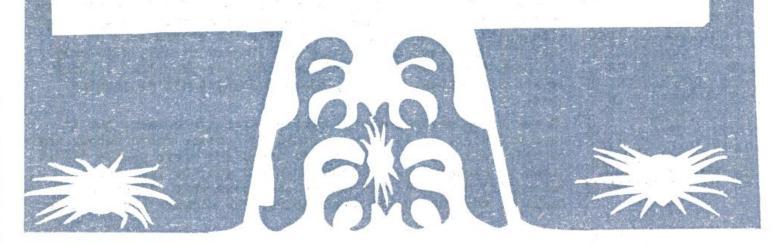

Although we are still at the beginnings of a true FREE COMMUNITY PRESS and only just starting to tackle the major task of subverting the hucster thing with free energy, free music, free joy, free resources, the past year has made this country into one of the international centres of digger action -European Style In England it happens, & it is turned-on to the world yoga!

some European countries are about now into the is mation of their own co-ordinated Underground. Some, like Holland, have had an Underground from the start, but digger

action in Holland -& most European countrys - is still relatively new & faced with most of the hang-ups that dogged the formation of the Alternative Community here. Holland for instance has nothing that corresponds to the 3 villages; it has no digger publications or services as yet, operating in or beyond the main citys.

We have contacted only two active digger groups working on these problems, The Digger Radicals in Amsterdam,& Kargadoor, in Utrecht, and both groups want to extend communication with diggers here

There have been suggestions to do this with a regular exchange of digger material -Free Press information of every kind- between the two countrys not only the important ideas but things like leaflets, manifestos, hand - outs..whatever stimulates ideas & gives a touch-sense of the community making and living.

We have undertaken to make some initial contacts here with communes and diggers & with editors of the so-called 'small' press who would be willing to send regular copies of their publications, or etc, to Holland and if the scheme develops, to any other communities abroad who want to do it with us --including, we hope, Latin America. The proposal is that the Exchange should be FREE; no return sales, no price on the material exchanged and the cost of postage either paid independently by those taking part, or shared if the project would operate better through a coordinating Centre.

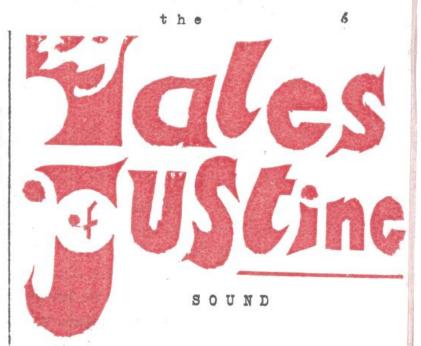

¿ REVOLUTION?

'Tolerance is not the opposite of intolerance, but is the counterfeit of it.' Thomas Paine

This is the generation of the revolutionary. Student, Hippy, Digger, Maoist and whathaveyou are now pressing for the 'New World', the 'New Life'. They are showing and shouting their denegration, their hatred, of the Established Way, the Traditional, stagnating Democracy, and pedantic Culture.

Fully equipped with their badges and slogans, posters and pamphlets, these groups, as seperate cells of dissent, or on masse for the louder and more active demonstrations, express their complete disapproval of aggression, racialism, lost individualism, dogma, fragmentation, and chauvinism.

The cry, the chant, is for the New Way! And down ---particul-arly down---with the Old!

Amid all this altruism and seething pragmaticality, there is, of course, the esoteric humour. And it is in this ---this rather rancorous humour---that the embryo of revolution can be seen breathing. It is also in this humour of disgust and incomprehension of such things as 'Alfs' and suburban 'Cabbages' that the specious arguments and the credence of the sincerity are shadowed by something far more insidious: revenge.

Let us consider these points:

The majority, and a very large majority it is, of these dissenters have derivated from the very same strata that these Mlf30 and 'Cabbages' thrive in: the Working and Lower Middle classes. But the dissenters have a difference, and an advantage, that their forebears never had and——and this is the important factor——never had a chance of. This is the strata of servility, the sterile mind, and the inarticulate; born from an age that used the pulpit to instill humility, and its established mediums to spoon feed patriotism. From this grew the rationalizing by props of their position: 'pride in one's job';respectability' and 'knowing your betters'. They also——and here is another facet of the catalyst for revolution ——they tried to pass on this negativity, gullability, and apathy to their children:

pater familiar, the family unity....and 'bringing you up properly'.

All this, that is, until the State Education was at last properly used.

Now we have a dichotomy. We have this established and reactionary strata finding within itself a cancerous, frenetic growth. But no silent bete noire this; words are known by it; words that are far more meaningful than 'respectability' and 'bathnight', 'brownandmild' and 'goldwatch'. And it had a mind. A mind too active, too elusive, to be bottled and placed on the kitchen shelf with the dried fruit and pickled onions. But it found no appreciation of its ideas; it saw no pride for its indomitable spirit. So the cuckoo, too large for the nest, flew off. Gregariousness being ineluctable, the new Cains soon formed their own society: fragmented, secular, and quixotic. Diverse though their ways and means were, they were all intent on the same end: the 'New Life', and the destruction of the old Establishment.

But how exactly is this 'New Life' going to be organised in the post-revolutionary period? And by whom from which faction? Just how different will this life be?

Questions such as these are either skillfully avoided; or the answer is so nebulous and dreamlike as to be completely unenlightening. True, one or two alternatives are already overt: the 'Woodbine' will be replaced by 'pot', and the old brown and mild by Spanish 'Sauterne'. But on the whole, bigger and slightly more important issues are being'left until afterwards'.

No, the prime concern of the new revolutionary is the destruction and dismissal of the present system; and with Voltarian enthusiasm and Micawberish hope they feel that something good will surely come from it all.

The mere fact that the preoccupation is for destruction rather than for creation, is a true indication of an underlying need for revenge. Revenge against a system that atrophied the minds of their parents; a system that was upheld, paradoxically both willingly and unknowingly by the 'Alfs' and 'Cabbages'. And so they, the revolutionaries, are going to tear away, eradicate, burydead.....all these things which their fathers found reverential, enigmatic, and incomprehensible. They are, in fact, out to erase the cause of their parents mental bondage....and consequentialy their own shame of their parents. What one might call Psychological Backlash.

It seems then, that the badges, the manifestos, the magazines, the whole miagra of canned and contrived dogma and second-hand ideals.....is for a revolution that should have taken place fifty years ago.

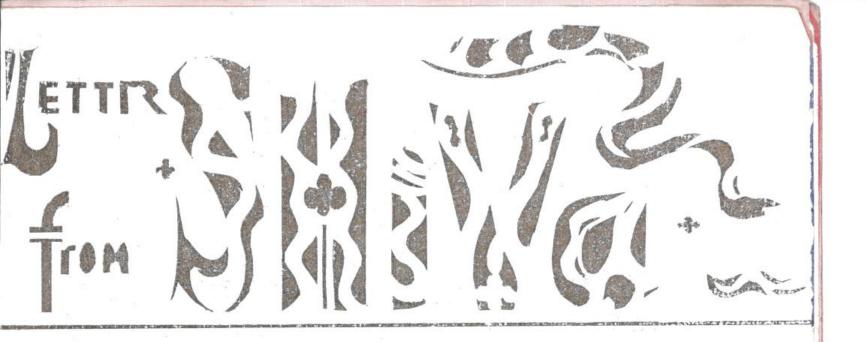

Dave Stringer's criticism of, what he calls, *...the weird alienating behaviour of some digger groups, which deliberately sets them apart* (REPORT ON THE NORTH, HAPT 5), prompts me to offer an explanation in support of the 'way-out' dress which bugs so many people.

The writer did in fact give us the key in his article in the atatement that "dress is as much a slogan as words", it is only his interpretation of that slogan which I query, but in order to do that I must bring into question his conception of what the digger movement, and for that matter, the whole of the underground, is all about.

The diggers are the spear-head of the underground movement, consisting of people who are very much aware of the creative potentials of the environment and the relevance of their actions in that environment. They are people who experience the ALTERNATIVE SOCIETY as an organic, living thing, existing, not in the future, but in the here and now, they are, in fact, the manifestation of the ALTERNATIVE. This alone is the digger message. The digger movement is NOT concerned with trying to persuade straight people to our way of thinking, as many people in the underground think we should, but simply to get on with the job in hand -namely that of making the ALTERNATIVE a more powerful force.

To persuade 'straight people', it is necessary to compromise, for they want moderation from us, they want to see changes come about through the established channels, following proceedures with which they are familiar, FOR THEY ARE NOT PREPARED TO EXPOSE THEMSELVES TO THE CREATIVE AND ORGANIC EXPERIENCE OF "FREE-FALL".

As Dave rightly says, "...diggers being humanitarian, should see the LIVING BEING in ALL people", this we do, but we are also painfully aware of the 'persona' that has been created, that odious mask that has developed through a history of spiritual ignorance, fear and tyranny, and which has so successfully replaced 'Essential Man'. The 'persona', this abstract personality, has drawn a veil, seperating man from man and man from HIMSELF, while diggers and the 'turned-on' people of the underground, strive to re-discover their humanity, and retrieve their butchered minds from the 'processing' that has been their fate since they took their first breath. They work to liberate their humanity from the bondage of the 'persona', to understand the nature of the world in which we live, technology feed-back, the influences of mass media and how to counter them in the mind, while at the same time the 'persona' becomes a more tangible force and humanity becomes less and less human. I8) Drupada and the sons of Drupadi, O Lord of earth, and the strong-armed son of Subhadra, on all sides blew their respective conches.

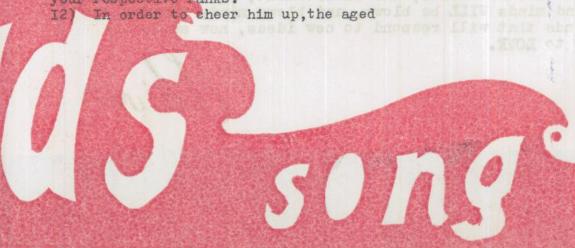
I9) The tumultuous uproar resounding through earth and sky rent the hearts of Dhrtarastra's sons.

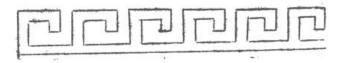
Throught the years, the word anarchy has become an unusable word in the English language. The people who adhere to the belief of anarchy (Anarchists) have become looked down upon, outcasts, untouchables. The word anarchy has been missused by both politicians and press alike and is now taken to be describing anything or anyone which does not conform to the governments or societies own code of moral living. The press describe a strike in a factory. or roits on the beaches as anarchy, and because of this it has become to mean choas and lawlessness, (definition from Oxford Dictionary). It is because of this that anyone who immediately preaches a belief in anarchism is condemmed.

However the original, and real, and only meaning comes from it's GREEK derivative... THE STATE OF A PEOPLE WITHOUT GOVERNMENT, WITHOUT HEAD NOR CHIEF'.

There is a vast difference between the original meaning and that of its English impostor. But this is only the fault of the press and of politicians that this mis-meaning of words has come about. Only due to their lack of understanding of words in the English language, and their meaning.

15 WHAT defence is there against that mind murdering process which goes under the guise of "education"? I'm not talking I'm not talking about education at colledge or university levels where an ever increasing number of students are now able to see through the gigantic 'con' that is being put over on them, much to the bewilderment of the establishment who are at a loss to account for why their promises of wealth, power, and security are no lenger enough to lull the student population into a state of submission, but education at a primary school level that I have in The vast number of infant and junior schools in our bourgeois towns and cities where the methods have not changed since my own school days and not noticably so since my fathers day, for it is here that the initial damage is done. SOME of you, like myself, may already be witnessing the devastating effects of this butchery on the mind of your child, most of you will probably be doing so in the not too distant future. We are involved in a We are involved in a situation in which we are in direct confrontation with the state, and under the threat of imprisonment we are forced to surrender our children to their tender mercies. This law, like many others, may well have been originally conceived with all sincerity for the good of the child at a time when poverty induced parents to send their children out to work at an early age. law like so many other laws made during periods of social reform, is no longer acceptable in a society where the individual, as such, is of no account and where education has degenerated into processing for industrial profiteering, robots for technology or, cannon fodder (an antiquated term in the age of nerwe gas!), according

(an antiquated term in the age of nerve gas!), according to the current need of the power structure.

VALUES and attitudes toward life are carefully cultivated in the child from the day he starts school and his chances of survival, as a human being, in the present structure of society, are not good unless a strong counter influence is brought into play, cancelling state authority. Teachers, let it be said, are genarally quite unconscious of the violence that they are inflicting upon their charge, for teachers, like all establishment figures, are not open to an ALTERNATIVE, for them there is only the one way, which is their

tragedy and ours too. DIRECT opposition at this stage is not possible and the domination of the state authority lingers on in the childs mind long after his school day has ended. The only defence that we, as parents, have is to examine very closely the methods used by the state "education" machine and then with great subtlety we may be able to To do this counter many of the harmful influences. successfully we must walk the razors edge, for to have the child openly rebel against the authority of the school would be to expose him to mental and physical violence as well as alienating him from his class-mates, thus creating a great deal of unhappiness for him and would probably result in him turning the venom of his frustrations upon his parents; bad vibrations all round. With a young child, his own personal comfort and happiness comes before all else and empathy, which is the motive force behind mature rebellion, does not develop (if ever) until much later. For the childs sake, parents must avoid using the child as an instrument for their own rebellion, teachers and other children alike can be very cruel; it is not uncommon for a boy with long hair to be told by his teacher that she will buy him a ribbon "like little girls have",

this exposure to public humiliation brings titters and sniggers throughout the classroom and succeeds in making the boy feel throughly wretched. This cruelty evident in childern, has led many people to conclude that aggression and cruelty is fundemental in human nature, the same theory is used to excuse wars and other abominations in human behaviour, what they fail to realize is the fact that young children are subject to the environment into which they are born and that the environment provided by the establishment and parents, is basicly aggressive, I am not denying that aggression is not latent in human behaviour but our present society is actually geared to bring it out. NOW let us briefly examine some of the attitudes that are cultivated in our children and how they benifit the state mac-No sooner has the child hine. commenced his schooling than he is introduced to 'religious' instruction which is not only subservient to the state for the obvious reason that the anti-Christ teachings have official approvalbut because the brand of christianity tought createes the acceptance of an heirar The spiritual nature of religchy. ion has been replaced by something which restricts spiritual awareness, The child is still taught the naive conception that there is a god up there who, if you dig him, will take you into his knigdom when you die while on the other hand, if you bug him he will reject Under the pretext of caring for vou. the childs spiritual and moral needs they are told to get on their knees and pray, and it is on their knees that the state intends that they should stay for the The pattern has rest of their lives. been set; god is conceived as the OMNIPOTENT AUTHORITY, once this has been accepted so early in life it is not difficult to accept the STATE in the same light later in life with unchallenged obedience. Young minds are easily manipulated; schools are run on the heirarchy principle, authority is established and authority excludes dialogue. Children are taught that there can be no dialogue with God, state or teacher for the only thing to learn is obedience. Lessons are administered under the threat of violence, which in itself restricts the

childs learn-

16 ing capacity, becaufear inevitably breeds confusion and a confused mind is unable to function with clarity. The fear principle is used, I have witnessed it in my own child and in others. ANOTHER basic principle that the state has been careful to cultivate in its children is the competitive drive. Much to our misfortune, we live in a competitive society in which the more educated of the community ruthlessly exploit in order to climb an illusionary ecconomic and social ladder, reaping its prize of respe-ct from the community, material wealth and the 'better jobs' (better jobs in the sense that they occupy the mind where as pure physical labour is not only chausting but tends to lull the mind into a thoughless stupor. However, in the last analysis both are jobs; which is not the same as people having a role in society). Less educated members of society, due to environment and class background, spend their lives in 'lowly jobs' and although not openly scorned nowadays, are generally looked down upon with some contempt and considered as failures in life. THIS then is the society for which our children are being groomed. Schools in working class areas or on council estates, introduce them to this competitive world but ill prepare them for it as the standard of education is poor and teachers disintersted and discontent with conditions and the overcrowded classrooms. THE princiciple of competion, with rewards for those who succeed and contempt for those who fail is taught in the very first class. Children who are able, through reasons of their own personal psychological make up, are able to record the necessery

This same child may well be condemed to the C stream for the rest of his natural life! With the exception of a few progressive schools throughout the country, the childs creative potentials are never taken into account. The nature of competition is aggression, the competitor has to bring into play his aggressive instincts AGAINST those with whom he is in compeating in order to get ahead of them. Aggression is the basic principle of the old order, it can be seen in the world of big business, it can be seen in politics and it can be seen in the arts and sciences. Sadly, aggression has become so respectable that it is taught in our schools, PEOPLE ARE UNABLE TO SEE THAT A WORLD RUN UPON CO-OPERATION RATHER THAN COMPETITION WOULD BE FAR MORE MORE BENIFICIAL TO ALL CONCERNED (with the possible exception of those at the 'top of the ladder').

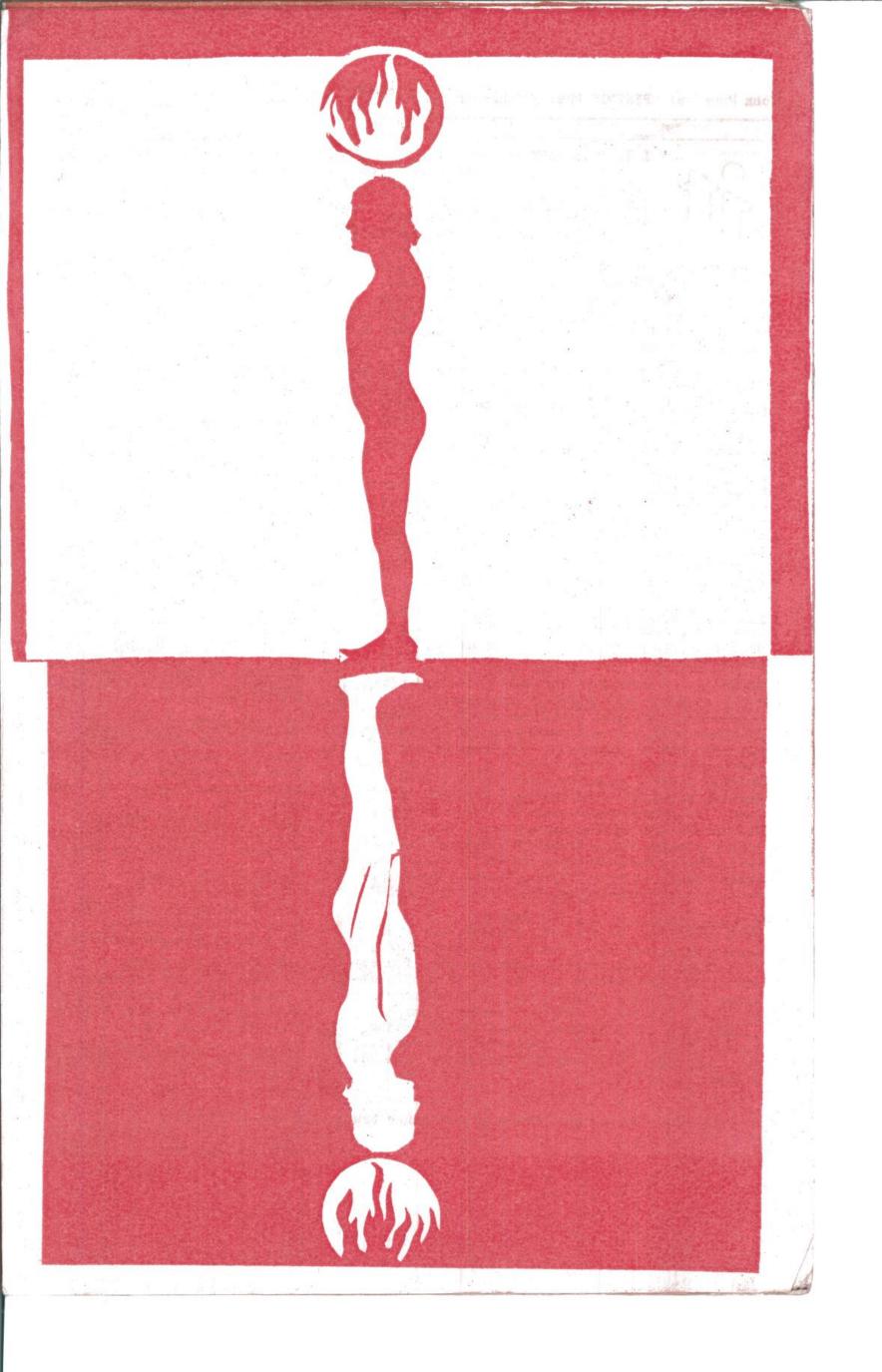

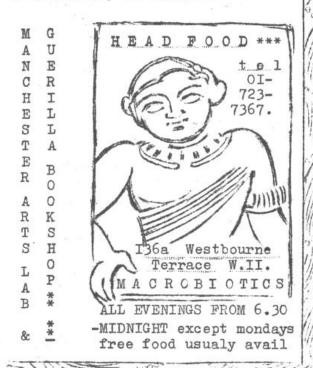

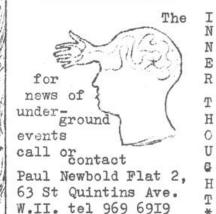
