

# Link Arms With Our Comrades at LSE

Continuous messages flooding into RSSF office indicate that there has been a tremendous response to the LSE appeal for solidarity. From Glasgow to Sussex, a national student movement has sprung up in opposition to the repression in higher education.

Latest news from the bases:-

BIRMINGHAM: 6 hour meeting on LSE yesterday, militants left to support Aston.  
ASTON: 40 occupied for 18 hours; handed in demands to V.C.  
ESSEX: 1500, (3/4 Univ.) , with some staff and Admin. Occupied lecture block in solidarity with LSE and about gates erected in Essex on Tues. All night discotheque still occupying.  
SUSSEX: Meeting now to decide about occupation.  
SHEFFIELD: Meeting now considering direct action and disaffiliation from NUS.  
LIVERPOOL: 35 occupied Admin. Block till this morning when they went to Union building to break up National Front meeting.  
READING: U.G.M. Friday condemning provocative action of Adams in erecting gates. Full support of students in attempt to reopen school and destroy gates.  
MANCHESTER: Lectures interrupted to discuss LSE; obnoxious gates everywhere being removed. Polytech occupying with Univ. over exams on Monday.  
LANCASTER: 50 occupied Senate Room till this morning. Guerilla last night in Admin Block.  
YORK: Meeting deciding on occupation tomorrow. News of victimisation of LSE students swung feeling of the meeting.  
OXFORD: Threats of rustication but bringing many coaches for Monday's Demonstration.  
GLASGOW: Occupying with Strathclyde at 6-30 tonight.  
ABERDEEN: Meeting now to discuss LSE  
Ipswich College: Solid support from meeting.  
KENT: 150 occupying Keynes College.  
BRISTOL: Mass meeting yesterday  
HULL: Mass meeting tomorrow Token Occupation probable.  
CAMBRIDGE: Tore down gates outside two colleges and threw them in the river. / 300 still occupying Admin Block  
WARWICK: 300 in 24 hour occupation of library. Demands to VC. /00 demonstrated outside Coventry Evening Telegraph this morning. VICTIMIZATION Each Dept asked to name those absent on demo. Resignations of staff imminent.  
DURHAM: Support from meeting of 800.  
West Ham: Solidarity motion and £20 to LSE defence fund.  
NEWCASTLE: Univ. and Tech. meetings in support of LSE. Demo on Saturday.  
SWANSEA: Meeting smashed by Right Wing. Union meeting tomorrow.
