Two against one

The LSE authorities, 40 odd Vice Chancellors, the N.U.S. clique, are still crapping on about small minorities of militants causing all the 'trouble'.

Adams and Robbins talk of having the interests of the vast majority of students "in mind" and blame their closing the school onto a tiny number of determined militants.

And at the same time they treat the staff and students like dogs, demanding "obedience to the director" and putting up iron grills throughout the buildings.

Their idea of a majority is passive acceptance of their rule. Now their long held contempt for students has turned into hatred for the militants. Why? Because militants argue, criticise and present an alternative. Their opposition gives all students the opportunity to debate and choose. The authorities think they can annihilate this newly won freedom in the only way they know — by removing militants. They will try to return the mass of students to silence. They are too late.

A Violent Minority

'The police have been called into LSE because the students have at last used violence' sigh Adams and Robbins. Iron gates are swiftly and efficiently removed after a majority vote of the students union so decides. This is the highest form of violence, the use of force against capitalist property: its name is liberation.

Adams and Robbins are willing to deliberately use force against indivuduals. They have 'non-violently' called in police, have 'non-violently' forced students to march through a police line, they have 'non-violently' picked out the ones they wanted arrested and found guilty. They will now attempt to 'non-violently' victimise the representatives of the students. This is the lowest form of violence: its name is terror.
