Olivier's work frequently collides multiple histories and memories with present-day narratives. Familiar objects, spaces and locations, altered in function and medium, create uncanny meditations on stagnancy and the weight of materiality. Her sculptures and installations explore the politics and poetics of space, and the role of viewers in shaping their own experience and engagement.

A recipient of the 2018 Rome Prize for sculpture, Olivier [b. Trinidad and Tobago], currently is Head of Sculpture at Tyler School of Art, Temple University, Philadelphia, PA.
