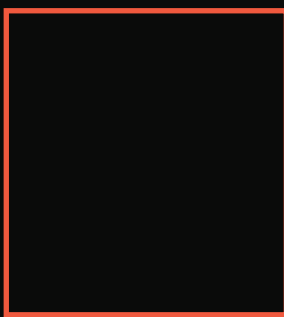
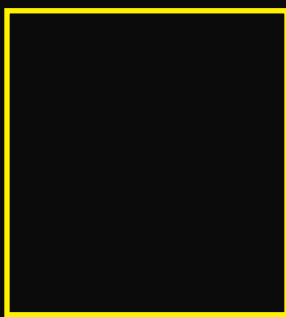
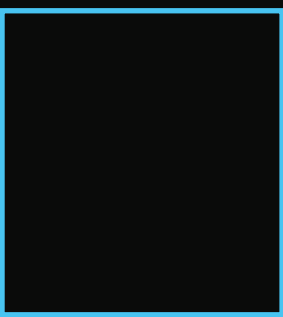

THE AGE OF TAURUS
Polytheism –

Many gods, often zoomorphic, or representing aspects of nature, requiring human sacrifice.

THE AGE OF ARIES
Monotheism –

One god, a supreme anthropomorphic being, located in space or associated with a place, requiring animal sacrifice.

THE AGE OF PISCES
Theism –

God as Oversoul, Spirit separate from Matter, or the world, located in time (holy days), requiring a sacrifice of time, energy and fleshly desires.

THE AGE OF AQUARIUS
Panteism –

God is all and everything, imminent and transcendent, located in the visible and invisible, requiring a sacrifice of awareness and intention to the divinity in everything.
