The History of the Silver Street Cemetery

Granville, Massachusetts


The Silver Street Cemetery began when "A plot of land nine rods long from north to south and extending back from the road called Silver Street was fenced off and probably originally donated as a burial place."¹ The oldest inscription is that of William C. Marvin who died March 24, 1808, supporting the idea that this tract was in use as a cemetery several years before Jonathan B. Bancroft and Ohel Spelman officially deeded the site to the East Parish on March 27, 1829.² The Silver Street Cemetery was the third cemetery to be built in Granville, according to Albion Wilson, in his History of Granville Massachusetts. The East Parish "burying ground" was originally fenced with a wooden fence. In 1829, it was decided to replace the broken fence with a stone wall and a contract was drawn up for the wall to be laid at the price of one dollar a rod, the builder to furnish and draw his own stone.³ Two thirds of the original wall still remains in good repair, part of the wall was removed as additions were made to the site. Providing enough lots to meet the growing needs of the community was the

bigest challenge the Proprietors and Owners of the Burying Ground in the Southeast School District faced. On May 13, 1859, an additional half acre of land, was obtained from Sparrow Crosby.⁴ On November 18. 1892, a piece of land was purchased from Charlotte E. Malone, described as an irregular shaped lot 225 feet on Silver Street and about 178 feet deep, southeast of the last mentioned piece.⁵ The Association also secured the deed from the East Parish conveying the Bancroft plot and the Crosby plot to the Association on March 15, 1893.⁶ In 1895, November 18, the purchase of another piece of land described as forty foot wide on the highway and running to a point at the southeast corner of the cemetery was purchased from Sherman Beckwith.⁷

Cemetery in 1910



On May 15, 1915, another acre, more or less, extending southerly as far as a private road of Ralph B. Cooley, was purchased.⁸ In 1934, the final addition was obtained from Ralph B. Cooley. On the northerly side of the cemetery , running 400 feet on Silver Street and 300 feet deep, having the easterly line parallel with the highway, bringing the southeast corner of the plot around into the rear of the original walled in area.⁹ These additions more than tripled the original cemetery.

In 1892, The Granville Cemetery Association printed booklets containing the bylaws of the cemetery. These included rules for plot purchasers, as well as committee members. The purchase price of a 5 person lot was \$50.00 with perpetual care.

By-Laws.

ARTICLE 1. The Association shall be called and known by the name of the PROPRIETORS OF THE GRANVILLE CEMETERY.

ART. 2. The Officers shall consist of a President, Clerk, Auditor, Treasurer, and a Board of Trustees consisting of four members. It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all meetings of the Proprietors, and in case of his absence the senior member of the Board of Trustees present shall preside in his stead.

ART. 3. All the Officers shall be chosen by ballot. The President shall be ex-officio member of the Board of Trustees.

ART. 4. The Treasurer shall collect and safely keep the funds of the Association, and disburse or deposit them under the direction of the Trustees, and shall report all funds in the treasury to the Trustees, whenever requested by them so to do. He shall annually on the third Wednesday in April render in writing, to the Trustees, a full account of his official acts and a detailed report of the state of the treasury. He shall give bonds in an amount and with sureties satisfactory to the Trustees for the faithful discharge of the duties of his office, and said bond shall be kept in the care of the Clerk.

ART. 5. The Officers shall be chosen annually on

the third Wednesday of April in each year, but in case of any omission so to choose the incumbents shall hold their offices until others are chosen and qualified in their stead. No Proprietor shall be elected to more than one office.

ART. 6. The Trustees shall have the general care and superintendence of the Cemetery and grounds; shall enclose, ornament, improve and allot the same, and shall sell the lots either at public or at private sale as they shall judge expedient; the planting for rural adornment shall be kept strictly under the control of the Trustees; and no person shall change the grade of any lot without their consent. They shall have the power to remove any effigy, monument, or any structure whatever, or any inscription, or anything placed in or upon any lot or place in the Cemetery which shall be deemed by them offensive or improper. No trees within the grounds shall be cut down, trimmed or destroyed without their consent. If any trees or shrubs situated in any lot of land, shall, by means of their roots, branches or otherwise, become detrimental to the adjacent lots or avenues, or dangerous or inconvenient to passengers, it shall be their duty and they shall have the right, to enter into the said lot and remove the said trees and shrubs, or such parts thereof as are detrimental, dangerous, or inconvenient. No fence or curbing shall at any time be placed or erected in or around any lot, the materials and design of which shall not first have been approved by the Trustees, or a com-

mittee of them. No tomb shall be constructed within the bounds of the Cemetery, except in or upon the lots situated in such parts of the grounds as shall be designated by the Trustees for that purpose; and no Proprietor shall suffer the remains of any person to be deposited in a tomb so authorized, for hire. The Trustees may at any time enter upon any lot to keep the same neat, and clear off the grass and weeds therefrom, and appropriate the said grass and weeds to their own use.

ART. 7. The title to the land shall be vested in the President for the time being and his successors in office, in trust for the uses of the Association and their assigns; and he shall execute deeds of lots to those persons to whom the Trustees shall sell.

ART. 8. Meetings of the Proprietors shall be called by the Clerk by the direction of a majority of the Trustees; and in case any number of the Proprietors exceeding five shall apply to the Trustees they shall give such direction to the Clerk; and in case of their refusal, such meeting shall be called by the Clerk on the application of said number so applying as aforesaid.

ART. 9. Notice of meetings shall be given in such manner as the Trustees shall determine.

ART. 10. A plan shall be drawn of the grounds of the Cemetery. The lots shall be marked off and numbered, and whenever sale is made of a lot the deed shall be recorded in a book to be kept for that purpose.

ART. 11. No monument for the division of the lots shall be erected except of stone or iron.

ART. 12. The Trustees shall convey no lot or lots to any person for the purpose of re-sale.

ART. 13. Any person owning a lot in said Cemetery, or one representative of such lot, or any person, upon payment of Ten Dollars into the treasury of said Association, may become a member of said Association and be entitled to vote at its meetings.

ART. 14. No deed of any lot in the Cemetery shall be delivered until the lot is fully paid for. If any lot is not fully paid for within one year from the date of the agreement for sale the Trustees shall resume possession of such lot and put it in order for re-sale. The Trustees may, however, by vote extend the time for payment in any case for more than one year.

ART. 15. Any one or more of these By-Laws may be amended or repealed at any meeting of the Proprietors, by a vote of two-thirds of the members present, after a notice is given the Proprietors by postal card at least five days prior to said meeting, stating the object of said meeting.

ART. 16. The Clerk shall record the doings of all meetings of the Association and Trustees, and record all deeds given of lots, and shall give notice of the annual meeting and all special meetings by postal card.

ART. 17. An Auditor shall be chosen by ballot at each annual meeting, and shall perform the duties usual to such office.

ART. 18. All deeds of lots shall be made subject to these By-Laws, and to any which shall be hereafter regularly adopted.

ART. 19. The foundations of all monuments shall be of solid masonry extending to the bottom of the grave, and all upright headstones and copings shall be substantially set in foundation of solid masonry of sufficient depth to be below the reach of frost, and all foundations, copings and headstones, shall be set to the satisfaction of the Trustees.

ART. 20. All bequests in trust or any funds appropriated especially for care of any lot shall be recorded in the book of records of the Cemetery Association, and a record kept of what expenditure has been made of the funds or income.

ART. 21. No lot shall be used for any other purpose than as a place of burial for dead persons.

ART. 22. The opening and closing of graves and disinterments shall be done by direction of the Trustees.

AT THE ANNUAL MEETING, APRIL 17, 1895.

VOTED: That upon payment of Fifty Dollars to the Cemetery Association, to be by them held in trust, and income of same used for that purpose, perpetual care shall be given such lot in said Cemetery as shall be designated by the donor.

6. All foundations for monuments, headstones, or any objects, shall be built under the direction of the Superintendent.

7. All workmen employed in the construction of vaults, erection of monuments, landmarks, or any other work, shall be subject to the control and direction of the Superintendent.

8. All materials brought into the Cemetery to be used in improving lots, shall be transported and deposited within the Cemetery in such manner as the Superintendent shall direct; and all earth, stone and rubbish accumulated in improving any lot must be removed and deposited under his direction by the lot owners or at their expense; or if not done immediately by the lot owners, then at their expense by the Superintendent, without any claim on the part of the lot owners for such earth or stone.

9. All persons are required to confine themselves to the avenues and walks, and to avoid walking on the lots.

10. All persons are prohibited from writing upon, scratching, defacing or injuring any monument, fence or other structure, in or belonging to the Cemetery.

11. All persons are prohibited from picking any flowers, either wild or cultivated, or mutilating or injuring any tree, shrub or plant.

12. No teams shall be allowed on any part of the Cemetery except the avenues, without special permission from the Superintendent.

Rules and Regulations.

ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

1. The Board of Trustees shall choose annually one from their number as Superintendent, whose duty it shall be, under the direction of the Trustees, to take the general charge, oversight and control of all the grounds and affairs of the Association not otherwise specially provided for, subject to removal at their pleasure.

2. Graves shall be dug, interments and deposits in the Receiving Vault made, under the direction of the Superintendent.

3. No disinterment shall be allowed without permission being first obtained of the Superintendent, and the disinterring of bodies shall be under the direction of the Superintendent.

4. The Receiving Vault shall be under the general care and direction of the Superintendent. For placing bodies therein a charge will be made of \$2.00 if the body is to be removed for burial to other grounds. All bodies shall be removed from the vault by May 1st in each year.

5. The grading and sodding of all lots shall be under the direction of the Superintendent, and made to conform to the section in which the lot may lie.

13. Horses must not be left without a driver or without being fastened, and in no case can horses be fastened to trees or shrubs.

14. Any person disturbing the quiet and good order of the place, by noise or other improper conduct, will be compelled to leave the grounds.

15. The Superintendent, or other person having charge, is required to prohibit the entrance and cause the expulsion of all improper persons.

16. The Superintendent and employés are particularly directed and charged to see that the foregoing rules and regulations are enforced.


17. Whenever the Superintendent is absent from the town or is incapacitated for performing his duties, he shall have authority to delegate his powers for the time being to such person as he shall select.

Extract from Chapter 207 of the Public Statutes.

SEC. 49. Whoever willfully destroys, mutilates, defaces, injures or removes a tomb, monument, gravestone, or other structure or thing placed or designed for a memorial of the dead, or a fence, railing, curb or other thing intended for the protection or ornament of a tomb, monument, grave-stone or other structure before mentioned, or of an enclosure for the burial of the dead, or willfully destroys, mutilates, removes, cuts, breaks or injures a tree, shrub or plant placed or being within such enclosure, or wantonly or maliciously disturbs the contents of a tomb or grave, shall be punished by fine not exceeding \$1000 or by imprisonment in the jail or house of correction not exceeding 3 years.

SEC. 50. Whoever wrongfully, and by any act not included in the provisions of the preceding Section, destroys, injures, or removes a building, fence, railing, or other thing lawfully erected in or around a place of burial, or cemetery, or a tree, shrub, or plant situate within its limits, or wrongfully injures a walk or path, or places rubbish or offensive matter, or commits a nuisance therein, or in any way desecrates or disfigures the same, shall forfeit for every such offence not less than \$5 nor more than \$100.

Improvements to the cemetery grounds include a granite receiving vault built in 1902, funded by a donation from Mrs. Maria C. Holcomb.



Also, according to the Wilson History, running water was available in 1925.

The records of the annual meetings prior to 1935 were destroyed in a fire, but the records currently held include the following information:

- ★ In 1935, it was voted to plant Hard Maples along the outside of the cemetery
- ★ In 1948 a five grave lot price was raised from \$50.00 with perpetual care to \$75.00, with perpetual care \$110.00
- ★ In 1949 a two grave site was priced at \$50.00 perpetual care \$60.00
- ★ In 1953 a new cover was installed over the spring (Was this the "running water" mentioned by Wilson?)
- ★ By 1954, it was determined that the cemetery was running out of lots
- ★ In 1957 the Town of Granville helped to develop the southern portion of the cemetery into usable lots
- ★ In 1958 Harry Jensen donated 5-7 trees to line the street between the main road and the cemetery
- ★ In 1962 it was decided to build a blacktop road from the street to the vault
- ★ By 1964 the Roadway was completed
- ★ In 1964 water was provided by a holding tank and pipeline, and the tank was filled as needed by the Granville volunteer fire department

- ★ In 1967 The Shade Tree Cemetery Fund was the title used for the opening of savings and checking accounts
- ★ In 1976 an individual lot sold for \$100.00
- ★ In 1979, the Northern tiers were developed for lots. This section is 360 ft long by 150 foot deep by 40 foot wide. It needed to be cleared of trees and brush and stumps and seeded. Work was completed by 1980 and it was ready to be seeded by 1981.
- ★ In 1986, the town of Granville was asked to help fix the roadways in the cemetery.

In 1985 single lots still sold for \$100.00, by 1988 they were sold for \$150.00. Prices continued to rise, and in 1995, lots were \$200.00, in 2000, \$300.00, and as of 2003 lots were available for \$400.00 each.

The Silver Street Cemetery, as it is known today has a comparatively short list of officers who have held their positions for many terms. It has not always been easy to fill these positions. Occasionally the committee resorted to severe measures to maintain a qualified person in each position, as in 1947, when the minutes state no one was permitted to quit and in 1949 when all efforts to resign were fruitless.

Buel S. Dickinson served as secretary for 20 years and acting treasurer for 2 years. Roland Oversen served as President for 19 years and another 6 years as secretary. The current record holder for most years of service, however, is Vaughn Banks. Mr. Banks began as caretaker of the cemetery in 1960 for the hourly rate of \$1.50 an hour. He was also elected trustee in 1960. He was largely responsible for the clearing of the North Tiers in 1979. He served as president from 1977-2003 filling in as secretary in 1986 and 1987, for a total of 26 years as President and a total of 43 years as a board member. In 2003 Vaughn Banks stepped down from his role as President, passing the title of President to Bill Blakesley. Mr. Banks continues as a Trustee offering assistance and advice as needed.

Continuing the tradition of long held posts, Gary Petersen has served as auditor since 1983. Current Officers, Nancy Petersen and Herb Hiers have held the offices of treasurer and clerk respectively since 1988.

President Bill Blakesley began in office in 2003. The Silver Street Cemetery looks forward to many years under his leadership.

In 1910, the existing three tiers, as well as the other five cemeteries of Granville, were surveyed by Mr. Lawrence F. Henry of Granville for the New England Historical Society. His work was typed and indexed with permission by Mrs. Max Lederer for deposit in the Granville Library, where it is available for use by the public. At the 2004, annual April meeting of the Silver Street Cemetery Committee, it was determined that a new survey of the existing stones in the cemetery was needed. Suzanne T. Hansen volunteered for the task. The information in this booklet is the result of a survey of the Silver Street Cemetery in May of 2004. Some stones are in poor repair and difficult to read, the 1910 survey was consulted in those cases. An alphabetized list of burial permits held by the Cemetery Association, (available at the Town Clerks office) follows the list of inscriptions. The list of Burial Permits arranged by date completes the booklet. There is some interesting spelling in the records, and I have tried to copy as I found it, please excuse any typing errors.
