Granville. November 19, 1781 the signers of the covenant publicly appeared at the west meeting-house in Granville, and after mature consideration and solemn prayer entered into its solemn engagements and became embodied in church order and communions.

Certified Aaron Jordan Booge

Minister of the Gospel who was desired to attend and assist in the important transaction

After the church had embodied they proceeded to choose a committee. Voted Col. Robinson, Capt. Aaron Coe, Lemuel Haynes, be a committee for the church. The whole transaction concluded by prayer.
