E. Wells Bronson 81
A Stock Raiser Dead

Granville, March 13, 1944.

Elmer Wells Bronson 81, died last night at Noble Hospital, after several weeks illness. He was born at Russell, the son of Isaac and Elizabeth Lindsey Bronson but had lived on the Blandford Road Granville for more than 50 years.

As a young man he was associated with his brother-in-law in the lumber business under the name of Stowe & Brunswick, but was better known in this section as a stock raiser. He specialized in raising fine oien and cows. Some years he raised and sold more than 50 head. He often drove as far as Hartford with horses to complete his sales.

He was a member of the Congregational Church (Centre) and last year he and Mrs. Bronson celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary.

Besides his widow Mrs. Elma Stowe Bronson, he leaves two sisters, Mrs. Florence

Roberts and Miss Louise Bronson of Waverley
and a brother Miles of Springfield, and
several nieces and nephews.

The funeral will be held at Granville
Centre Congregational Church, Wednesday
afternoon at 2. with Rev. E. U. Cowles. Burial
will be in Granville Chr. Cemetery.
