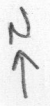

ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANCE Describe important architectural features and evaluate in terms of other buildings within the community.

This 2-story, 5-bay residence is related in form to other buildings with overhangs and central chimneys. Aluminum siding has obscured most of the detailing with the exception of fluted pilasters and sidelights on the south facade.

HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE Explain the role owners played in local or state history and how the building relates to the development of the community.

Between the ownership of the Atkins (1855, 1870 map) and the Downs (1912 map) Wm. G. Snow owned the property and published The Sun, Granville's newspaper from July 15, 1880 - July 15, 1881.
