Foreword

Eliakin Stow owned the land where Woodlands Cemetery is now located. He, and the first generation of Stows in Granville, are buried in the "Old Cemetery" (Route 57 West of Granville Center.)

Later, one of his heirs established a private family burying-ground. The first to be interred was Alsop Paine Stow, son of Aba and Betsey Bancroft Stow, who died February 2, 1816, aged 3 years and 10 months.

Over the years the cemetery has had several names. It was first known as Stow Cemetery, then, as it was opened up to others it became, First North Cemetery, and by many called Pond Cemetery. It received its official name, Woodlands Cemetery on October 25, 1912.

No list or map has been found, thus making only those with gravestones to be recorded. It is hoped as errors and omissions are discovered they will be corrected and added to this book.

This book is dedicated to the memory of three faithful and devoted women who worked tirelessly for the benefit of the cemetery. Minnie Williams Webb, Marie Beckman-Shaughnessy, and Winnifred Barnard Wiggin.
