NATIONAL REGISTER CRITERIA STATEMENT (if applicable)

ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANCE Describe important architectural features and evaluate in terms of other buildings within the community.

This 2-story, 4 x 5 bay gable-roofed building exhibits some fine Federal details. The building actually has two main facades. The east facade (pictured) features a doorway surrounded by pilasters supporting a cornice which encloses a fanlight and modillions on the roof eave. The 5-bay south facade (not pictured) is symmetrically alligned with a similar door treatment and a pedimented gable embellished with modillions. A gable-roofed entry porch, probably added in the 19th century, covers the entry on the north facade. Lintels cap all the 12/12 windows.

HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE Explain the role owners played in local or state history and how the building relates to the development of the community.

The house was built in 1800 by Daniel Gillette, its most illustrous occupant. He was a storekeeper and trader who came from Suffield, Connecticut. In 1808, he began and was master of a Lodge of Masons which met in the third floor hall of his home. The Lodge adjourned in 1832. He was also granted a tavern license in 1809.

The property was the home of S. Minor in 1855, Miss S. Smith in 1894 and Miss H. Smith in 1912.
