

The information contained on the following pages gives more data concerning these early families, such as births, marriages, children, and records of war service. This is most helpful in identifying ancestors. Some of this information was from Hattie Hall Moore's records of Tolland, Massachusetts, particularly, Hall, Parsons, Bancroft, and Burritt families, of which she was a descendant.

The major part of this compilation is the work of Mr. Benjamin Jones done before 1912. He devoted much of his later life in doing research on these early Granville families. It is to him that we owe a debt of gratitude for having so much historical information available at this time.
