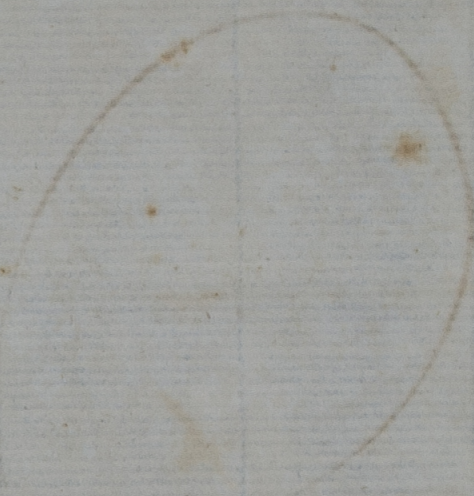

Resolved by this assembly that that part of the school Society
in Ferrisburgh within the boundaries of the town of Canton
be annexed to the school society in Canton for the purpose
of schooling only; any law to the contrary notwithstanding
And be it further resolved that the school funds
belonging to the school ^{Society} in Ferrisburgh be divided and
apportioned to the inhabitants of ^A Canton By this
resolution annexed to the school society in Canton their
Equal Proportion; and to be made on the 1st 1807—
General Assembly October session 1808—







the Gen^l. Assembly

This may certify that we the subscribers members
of the north east ^{School} district in Canton ^{have} recently
been informed that certain improper measures
have lately been taken to annex our district
to the north west district in said town
considering such a movement objectionable in
every point of view hereby express our entire
dissent and decided disapprobation of such a
measure that it is totally repugnant to our
interests and contrary to our wishes that no pro-
per application on the part of our district has
ever been made to the School Society nor has
our consent to the same ever been obtained or
expressed in any legal School meeting but that we
have been taken as it were by surprise and
against our interest and wishes therefore owing
to the extreme distance from us to the north
west district which would prevent our derivi-
ng any benefit whatever from an annexation to
that district we shall be opposed to ~~that~~ being
considered as members of that district or of
acting in any manner in any of their School
meetings it is our unanimous desire to contin-
ue a district by our selves as heretofore and
we shall act accordingly only in our own district
