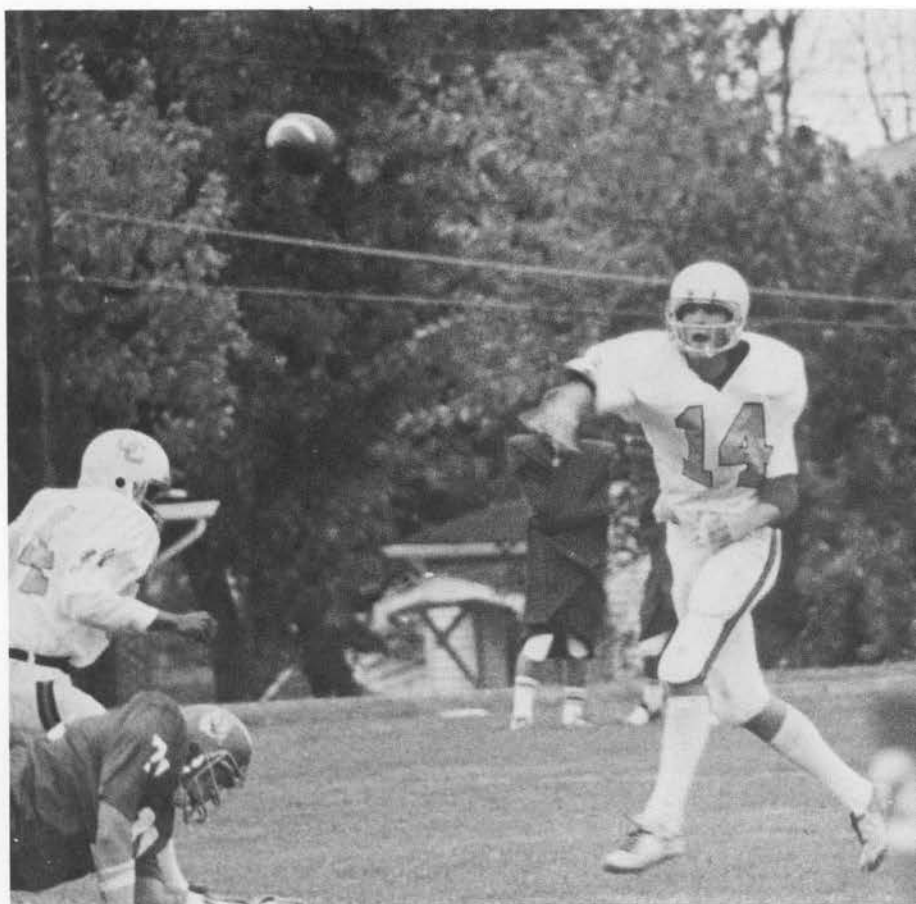




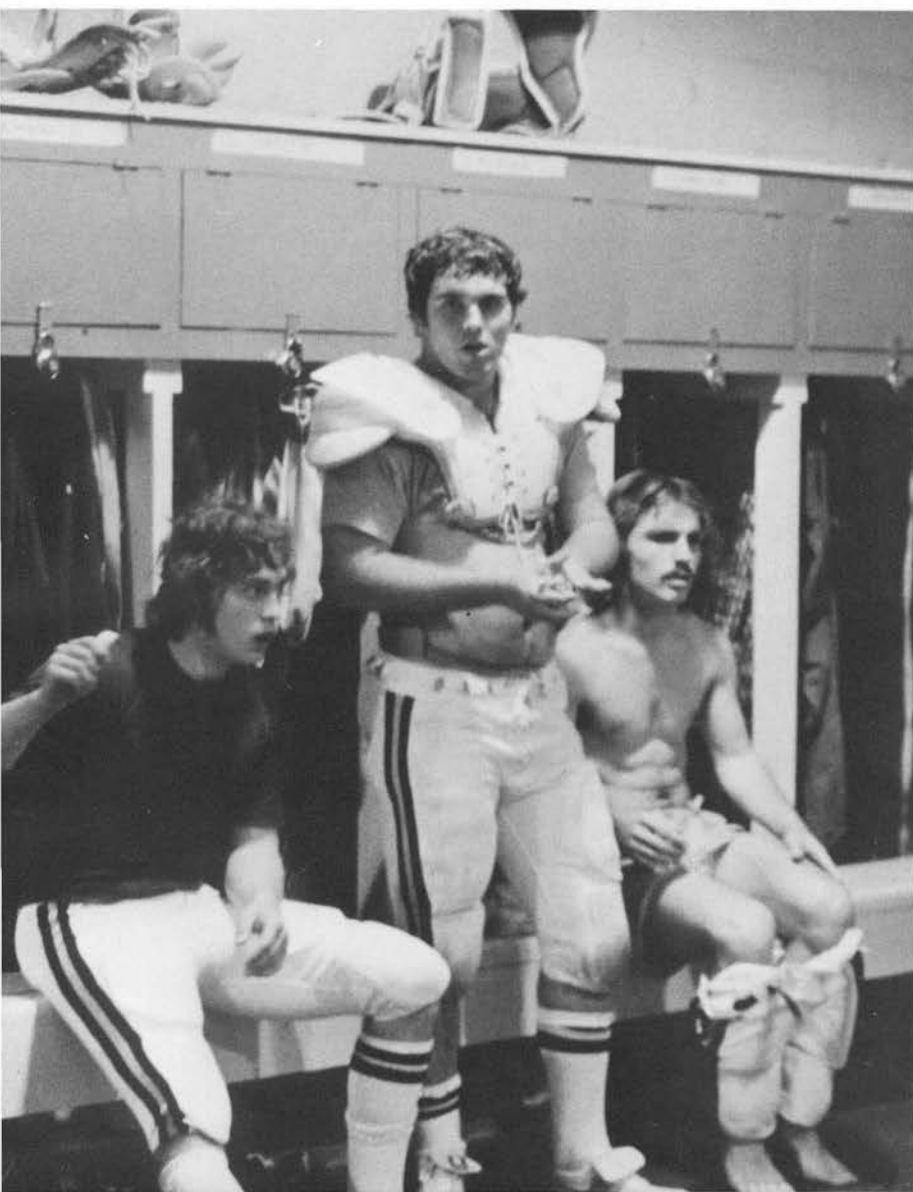
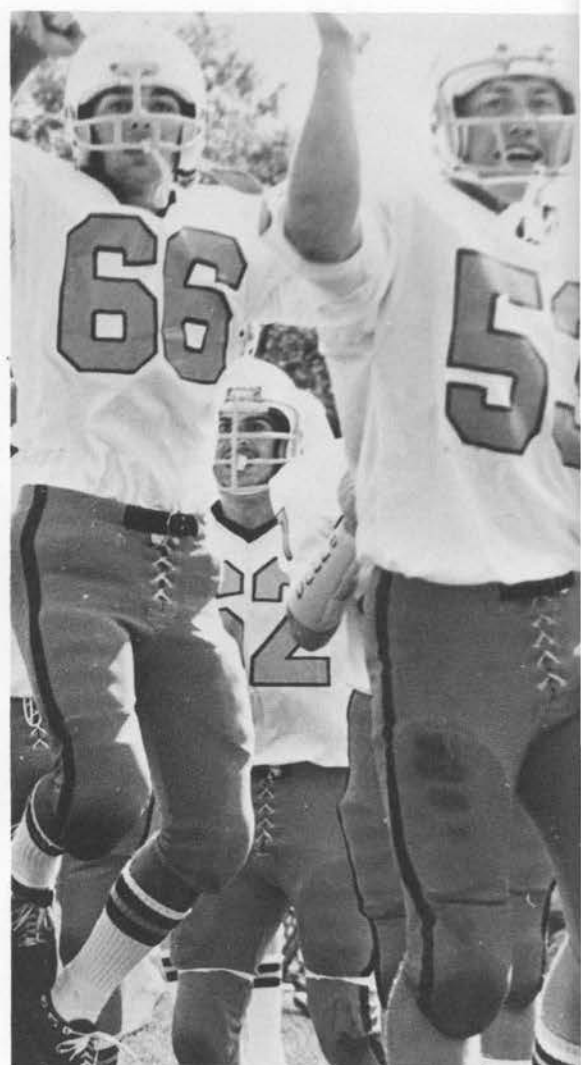
## Colonels Re-establish a Winning Season

The Colonels also finished second in the CAC behind co-champions Rose-Hulman and Sewanee. The team handed Rose-Hulman its only two CAC losses of the season.



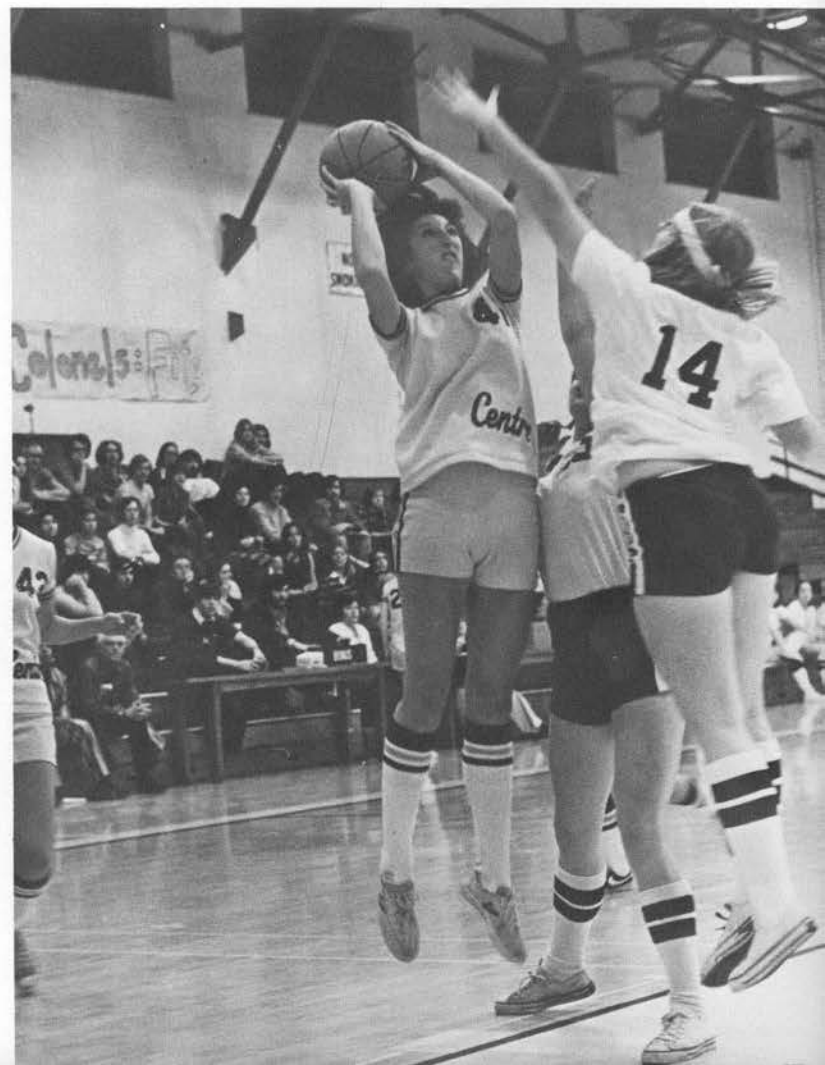

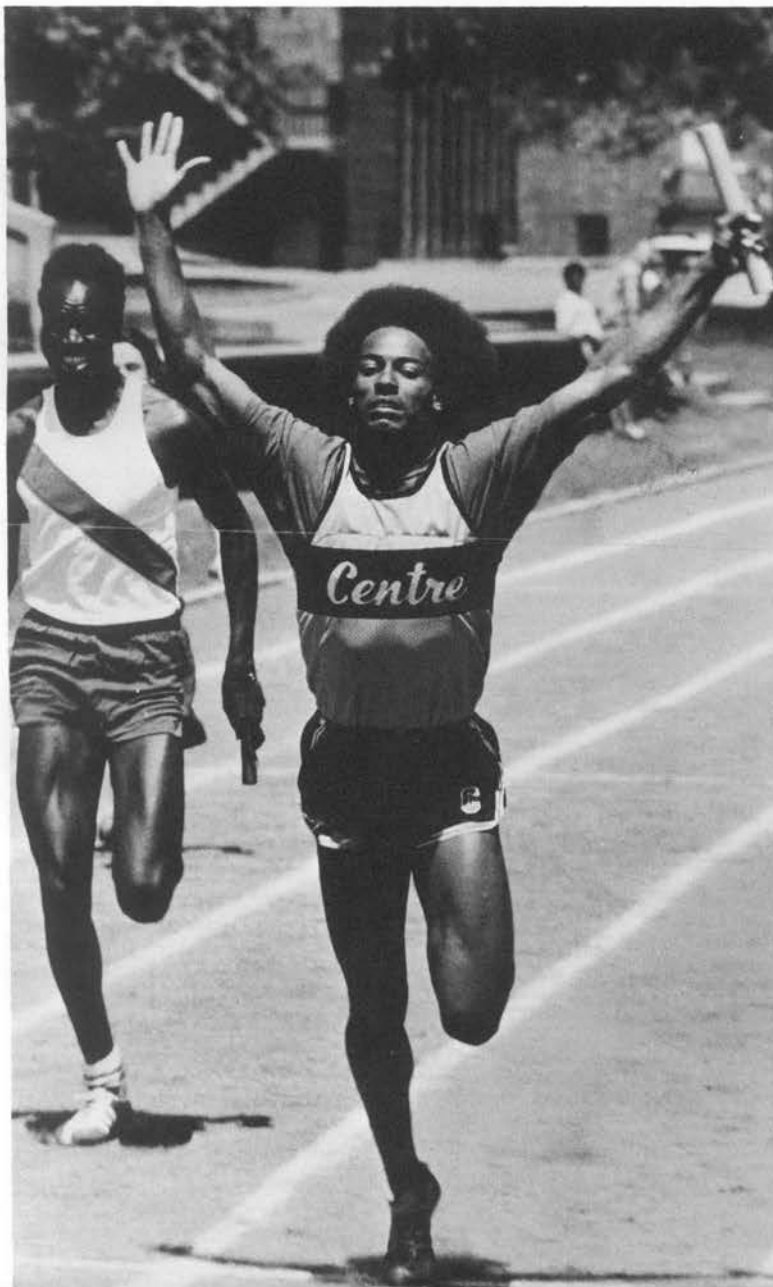
# Eight School Records



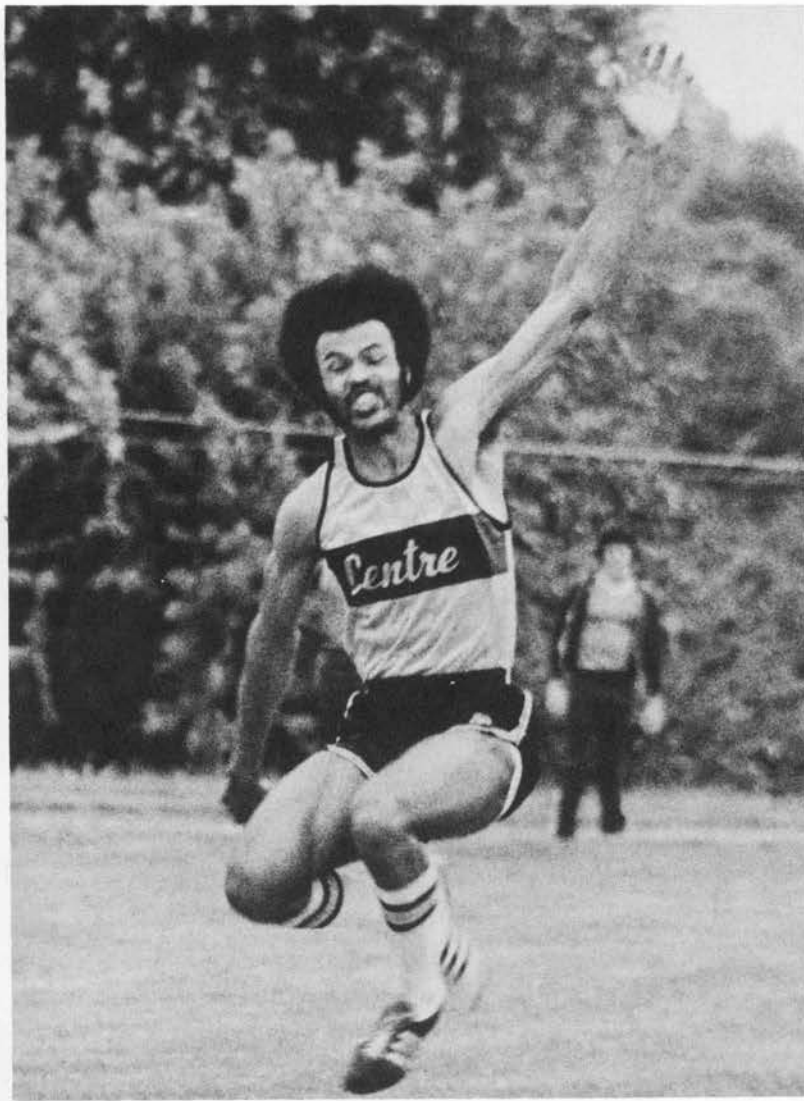
