On June 16th (Soweto day) a group of about 25 comrades occupied five South African connected banks in the City Centre. We started with the shopping centre Barclays, went on to the city branch which we managed to close down for 1/2 an hour. The employees (50 or so) were quickly told to leave by the management and the doors locked. Passers-by were informed by a notice that this was in commemoration of the massacre at Soweto. Other banks occupied were Barclays (International), Standard Chartered and the Clifton Barclays - in this one phone calls were answered on behalf of those comrades murdered by the South African police! - As usual there was a press blackout.
