Pharmacy College Is Moved

The move of the College of Pharmacy from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln campus to the NU Medical Center campus in Omaha became administrative reality Saturday

Dr. Albert Haskell, the new pharmacy dean, said it had been anticipated that the shift would not take place until mid-1973. "However, we were able to move more rapidly than we had originally planned," he said.

The shift in administration means basically that the college will come under the direction of the new chancellor of the Medical Center, Dr. Robert Sparks, and will receive its budgetary allocations from the Medical Center.

Only seniors in pharmacy will attend classes in Omaha this fall. Other pharmacy students will receive their education in Lincoln until such time as adequate classroom space can be built on the Medical Center campus.
