The majority of University of Nebraska-Lincoln dental college faculty members favor letting the NU Medical Center administer the college, UNL Chancellor Roy Young told the dental faculty Monday.

The NU regents academic committee will discuss the proposal Saturday. Whether it is put on their formal agenda later is up to the regents, said Dean Richard E. Bradley.

Young's survey shows 40 faculty members in favor of administrative realignment, 27 opposed. Of these, 26 are "strongly in favor" and 12 are "strongly opposed."

Students, facilities, faculty or programs would not move to Omaha, Young and the dean emphasized. Bradley would report to medical center Chancellor Neal Vanselow, not Young.

The American Dental Association says the present separation limits programs.
